

The Saturday CWF group is concluding an ENDOW study on Edith Stein this week and will next begin Jesus and the Eucharist from The Augustine Institute.





The Image of Divine Mercy Explained

by experts in the Marion Fathers

In 1931 God chose Sr. Faustina to be the administrator of His message of mercy. Her mission was to make humankind conscious of the fact that God is merciful. He is love itself and wants no one to escape His merciful love. Guided by His hand, the Lord asked Sr. Faustina to have an image painted. He said, "It should be given deep religious respect throughout the world, especially the Sunday that follows Easter."

In the image, Jesus is wearing an all-white, ankle-length linen vestment which signifies that of a high priest and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the Holy Eucharist.

His hand is raised to show He is bestowing the blessing of peace upon us.

The image also represents Christ's Crucifixion, when out of His pierced side streams blood and water. Now coming from His heart, this fountain of mercy washes us of our guilt and heals us of all our wounds caused by sin.

Unlike other images, Jesus is pictured in total darkness. This is a sign of Him, as the Good Shepard, piercing the gloom of our dark ages and seeking out lost souls with His guiding light.

Notice Jesus' left foot is forward, walking towards us. This shows His love put into action. He is coming to us, seeking us out.

In excerpt 1485 of Saint Faustina's Diary God said, "Be not afraid of your Savior, oh sinful soul. I make the first move to come to you for I know that by yourself, you are unable to lift yourself to Me."




