

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

READING I: Acts 15:1-2, 22-29

Some who had come down from Judea were instructing the brothers, "Unless you are circumcised according to the Mosaic practice, you cannot be saved." Because there arose no little dissension and debate by Paul and Barnabas with them, it was decided that Paul, Barnabas, and some of the others should go up to Jerusalem to the apostles and elders about this question. The apostles and elders, in agreement with the whole church, decided to choose representatives and to send them to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas. The ones chosen were Judas, who was called Barsabbas, and Silas, leaders among the brothers. This is the letter delivered by them: "The apostles and the elders, your brothers, to the brothers in Antioch, Syria, and Cilicia of Gentile origin: greetings. Since we have heard that some of our number who went out without any mandate from us have upset you with their teachings and disturbed your peace of mind, we have with one accord decided to choose representatives and to send them to you along with our beloved Barnabas and Paul, who have dedicated their lives to the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. So we are sending Judas and Silas who will also convey this same message by word of mouth: 'It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and of us not to place on you any burden beyond these necessities, namely, to abstain from meat sacrificed to idols, from blood, from meats of strangled animals, and from unlawful marriage. If you keep free of these, you will be doing what is right. Farewell!'"

It had a massive, high wall, with twelve gates where twelve angels were stationed and on which names were inscribed, the names of the twelve tribes of the Israelites. There were three gates facing east, three north, three south, and three west. The wall of the city had twelve courses of stones as its foundation, on which were inscribed the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. I saw no temple in the city for its temple is the Lord God almighty and the Lamb. The city had no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gave it light, and its lamp was the Lamb.

VI DOMINGO DE PASCUA

PRIMERA LECTURA: Hch 15, 1-2. 22-29

En aquellos días, vinieron de Judea a Antioquía algunos discípulos y se pusieron a enseñar a los hermanos que si no se circuncidaban conforme a la ley de Moisés, no podrían salvarse. A ellos les entregaron una carta que decía: "Nosotros, los apóstoles y los presbíteros, hermanos suyos, saludamos a los hermanos de Antioquía, Siria y Cilicia, convertidos del paganismo. Enterados de que algunos de entre nosotros, sin mandato nuestro, los han alarmado e inquietado a ustedes con sus palabras, hemos decidido de común acuerdo elegir a dos varones y enviárselos, en compañía de nuestros amados hermanos Bernabé y Pablo, que han consagrado su vida a la causa de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Les enviamos, pues, a Judas y a Silas, quienes les transmitirán, de viva voz, lo siguiente: 'El Espíritu Santo y nosotros hemos decidido no imponerles más cargas que las estrictamente necesarias. A saber: que se abstengan de la fornicación y de comer lo inmolado a los ídolos, la sangre y los animales estrangulados. Si se apartan de esas cosas, harán bien. Los saludamos'".

MANAGEMENT ACCORDING TO THE APOSTLES

If you've ever worked in any kind of organization, for-profit or not-for-profit, I'm sure you have attended a conference or two. Whatever our expectations going in, I usually find these conferences expose me to communication and problem-solving styles that are different from my own, nudging me into a little unexpected self-discovery. And it's a great opportunity to meet new people and do something different. Here's my idea for a leadership conference: The Management Style of the Apostles. Think about it, the only thing the Apostles had more abundantly than holiness was problems. Lots and lots of problems ... most of them of the human resources variety. It's no small feat, starting Christ's Church on earth. I wouldn't want to be project manager of that endeavor. The Acts of the Apostles is, in some ways, a big book full of problems and ways to solve them. It's a blueprint for tackling interpersonal issues in the manner of a true steward, who encounters every problem starting from the same place: What would my Master want? It's a question we should be asking ourselves every time we, too, encounter a problem — especially problems relating to other people. What is the truth in this situation, and how would God have me communicate it? How could I handle this in a way that is worthy of the name of my Master? In Acts, we see a lot of characteristics of everyday stewardship. We see the Apostles mindfully acknowledge the lack of peace that is posed by problems like false teachings, this Gospel's problem du jour. They prayerfully confront the obstacles to salvation posed by these issues. Always, always, always, their main objective is to reveal the will of God, remaining committed to the truth while helping newcomers find avenues to salvation. Maybe I'm just saying it because it's my idea — but it sounds like a conference we could all use. — Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS

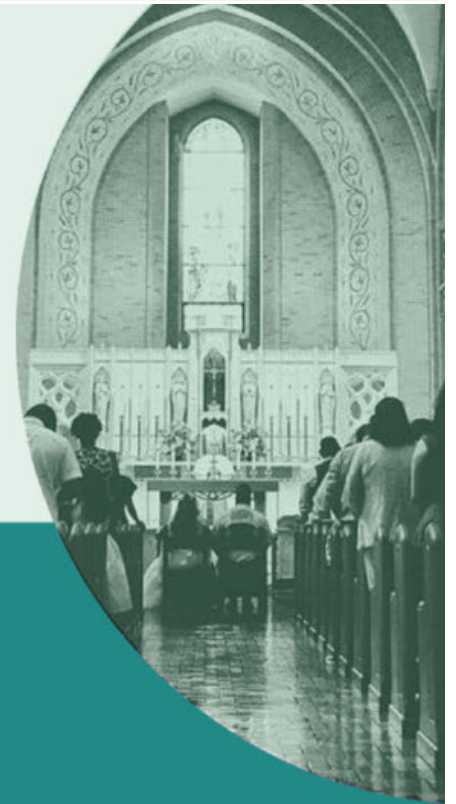

LA GERENCIA, SEGÚN LOS APÓSTOLES

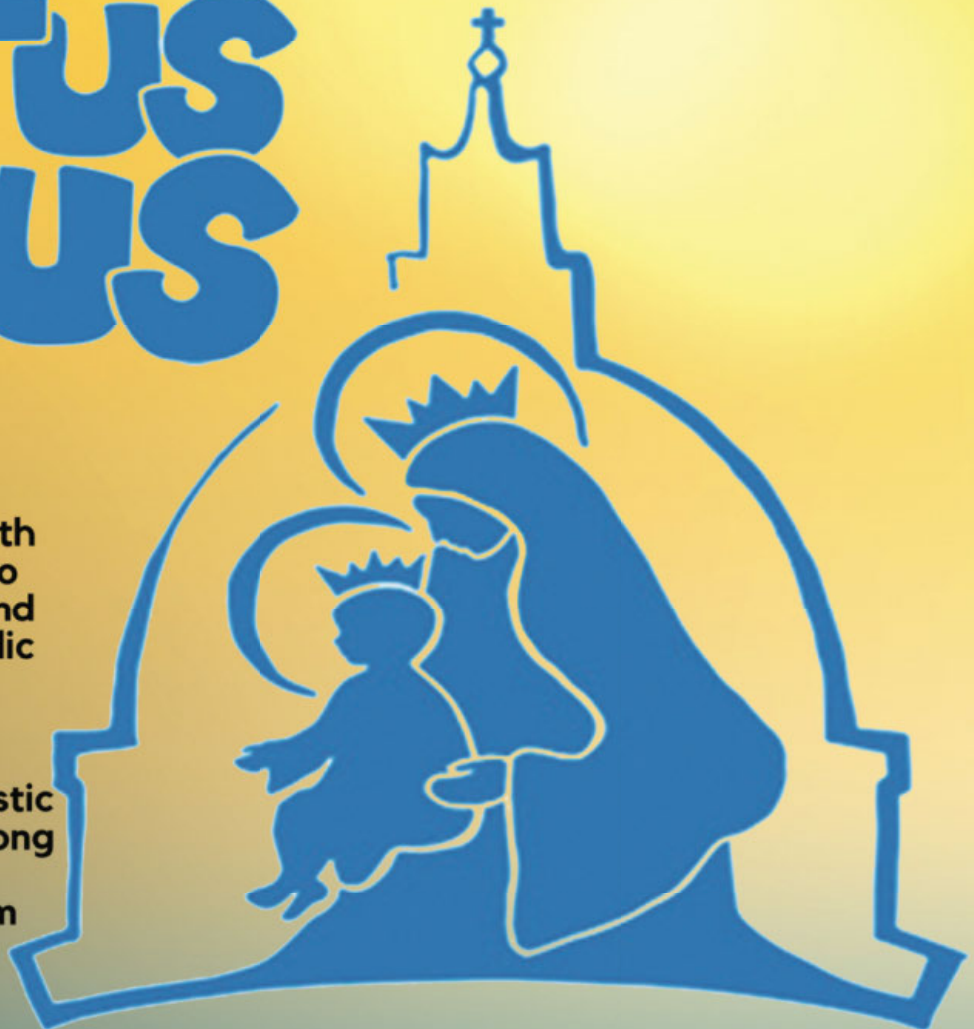
Si alguna vez ha trabajado en algún tipo de organización, con o sin fines de lucro, estoy seguro de que ha asistido a una o dos conferencias. Cualesquiera que sean nuestras expectativas, generalmente encuentro que estas conferencias me exponen a estilos de comunicación y resolución de problemas que son diferentes a los míos, empujándome hacia un pequeño autodescubrimiento inesperado. Y es una gran oportunidad para conocer gente nueva y hacer algo diferente. Esta es mi idea para una conferencia de liderazgo: El estilo de gestión de los apóstoles. Piénsalo, lo único que los Apóstoles tenían más abundantemente que la santidad eran los problemas. Montones y montones de problemas... la mayoría de ellos de la variedad de recursos humanos. No es poca cosa comenzar la Iglesia de Cristo en la tierra. No me gustaría ser gerente de proyecto de ese esfuerzo. Los Hechos de los Apóstoles es, en cierto modo, un gran libro lleno de problemas y formas de resolverlos. Es un modelo para abordar los problemas interpersonales a la manera de un verdadero mayordomo, que enfrenta todos los problemas desde el mismo lugar: ¿Qué querría mi Maestro? Es una pregunta que deberíamos hacernos cada vez que nosotros también nos encontramos con un problema, especialmente problemas relacionados con otras personas. ¿Cuál es la verdad en esta situación y cómo quiere Dios que la comunique? ¿Cómo podría manejar esto de una manera que sea digna del nombre de mi Maestro? En Hechos, vemos muchas características de la mayordomía diaria. Vemos a los Apóstoles conscientemente reconocer la falta de paz que plantean problemas como las falsas enseñanzas, el problema del día de este Evangelio. Afrontan en oración los obstáculos a la salvación que plantean estos problemas. Siempre, siempre, siempre, su objetivo principal es revelar la voluntad de Dios, permaneciendo comprometidos con la verdad mientras ayudan a los recién llegados a encontrar caminos hacia la salvación. Tal vez solo lo digo porque es mi idea, pero suena como una conferencia que todos podríamos usar. —Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS
