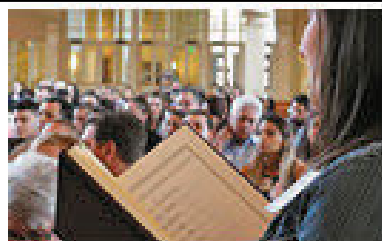
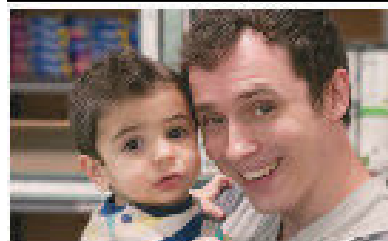

UP TO THE JOB

Have you ever had a job for which you didn't feel qualified? I think we all have, whether it was a paying gig or not. A lot of us parents often feel in awe of the magnitude of that role and lose sleep worrying that we made the wrong decision in one situation or a bad call in another. Some of us feel intimidated by what our communities need from us, on the parish level or in our personal relationships. Or maybe we are simply dreading a task that seems too big, too overwhelming — that necessary basement cleanout, or the weekly organization of family schedules. When we don't feel qualified, we don't want to do the work. We get stuck in our own fear. That's the birthplace of procrastination, self-doubt and bitterness. When we look inward at our own abilities, we can only see all the traits that aren't there. The intelligence, the dexterity, the ambition — whatever it is we lack, we get stuck on it.

I've got good news and bad news. I'll start with the bad news: none of us are qualified for the call of discipleship. We simply aren't. We don't have the love or grace or strength to get the job done.

Now I'll give you the good news: God knows this, and He doesn't care. Stewardship does not insist that we possess every good quality — no, as a way of life, stewardship recognizes that we lack so many qualities. But it shows us where to find the love and grace and strength we need. Stewardship does not demand that we know every answer; it merely reminds us who to ask when we don't.

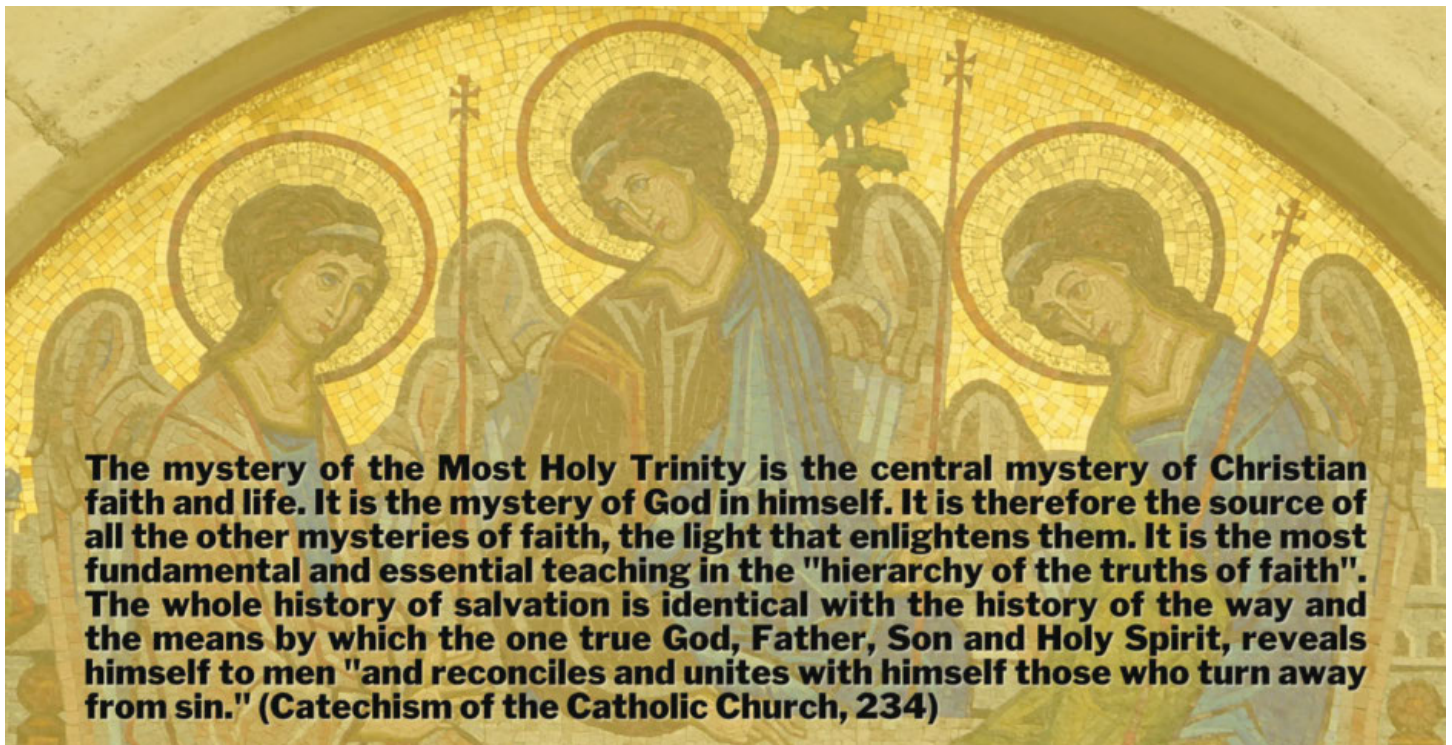
Dear Our Lady of Grace Parish and School Community,

After much prayer, discernment and conversations with multiple parties in our great community, I am pleased to share with you an update regarding the future of our wonderful school. My vision for the school is to bring in religious sisters to lead the school, and my conversations with Bishop Jugis and Father Reid, Vicar for Education, have progressed to the point where I am now able to share that approval has been given by the Diocese and a request is being made to a religious order. The timetable for this change has not yet been solidified, although we expect to remain in conversations with the sisters through the summer and into the late fall, with the hope that they are in-place in 2023-24. To that end, my conversations with the Catholic School Office and with Principal Catherine Rusch, have helped me discern how best to move forward for the upcoming year to allow for the continued flourishing of the school and to ensure that there is good continuity during this transition.

In a change from my previous communication, Mrs. Rusch will be staying on as principal during this interim transition as she is the leader best equipped to lead the school during this transition time. She is committed to the school, has my full support, and I know that alongside the support of the Catholic School Office and other Catholic culture experts, we will work together to continue ensuring that our parish and school community thrive in faith, academic excellence on all levels including those in Pace, and Quest programs. Please know that I will also be present and visible in the school community to reinforce my support for the school as a mission of our parish and as a place of formation for our young people as they work towards excellence in sanctity, academics, and virtue.

Lastly, I know that there has been some distress that has come out of the past couple of weeks regarding the future of the school, and well-intentioned individuals have sought to put their support behind what they believe is the best course of action. Please know that we are one Our Lady of Grace community and I appreciate the trust and support you will continue to lend our parish and school leadership as we move forward together unified, and not fractured. Please join me, Mrs. Catherine Rusch, the Catholic Schools Office, and the Bishop in supporting and praying together for the success of this mission and vision to grow in our greater mission of knowing, loving, and serving Christ as a part of our one Our Lady of Grace Community.

Querida Parroquia y Comunidad Escolar de Our Lady of Grace (Nuestra Señora de la Gracia),

Después de mucha oración, discernimiento y conversaciones con varios grupos en nuestra gran comunidad, me complace compartir con ustedes nueva información sobre el futuro de nuestra querida escuela. Mi objetivo y deseo para nuestra escuela es traer a hermanas religiosas para dirigir la escuela. Después de mis conversaciones con el Obispo Jugis y el Padre Reid, Vicario para la Educación, puedo compartirles que esta petición ha sido aprobada por la Diócesis y se está haciendo una solicitud a una orden religiosa. El periodo para este cambio aún no ha sido concretado, aunque esperamos permanecer en conversaciones con las hermanas durante el verano y hasta finales del otoño, con la esperanza de que estén ya en nuestra escuela para el año escolar 2023-24. Las conversaciones que he tenido con la Oficina de las Escuelas Católicas (the Catholic Schools Office of the Diocese of Charlotte) y con la Directora Catherine Rusch, me han ayudado a discernir la mejor manera de avanzar para el próximo año para ayudar al crecimiento y progreso de nuestra escuela y así garantizar que haya una buena continuidad durante esta transición.

En un cambio con respecto a mi comunicación anterior, la Sra. Rusch permanecerá como directora durante este tiempo ya que ella es la líder mejor calificada para dirigir la escuela durante este tiempo de transición. Ella está comprometida con la escuela, tiene todo mi apoyo, y sé que, junto con el apoyo de la Oficina de las Escuelas Católicas y otros expertos en cultura católica, trabajaremos juntos para continuar asegurando que nuestra parroquia y comunidad escolar prosperen en la fé, y la excelencia académica en todos los niveles, incluidos los de los programas PACE y Quest. Quiero decirles que también estaré presente y visible en la comunidad escolar para reforzar mi apoyo a la escuela como una misión de nuestra parroquia y como un lugar de formación para nuestros jóvenes mientras trabajan hacia la excelencia en la santidad, lo académico y la virtud.

Por último, sé que ha habido cierta angustia que ha surgido de las últimas semanas con respecto al futuro de la escuela, y varias personas, de buena intención, han tratado apoyar lo que creen que es la mejor decisión. ¿Alguna vez ha tenido un trabajo para el cual no se sentía calificado? Creo que todos lo hemos hecho, ya sea un proyecto pagado o no. O tal vez simplemente tenemos miedo de alguna tarea que parece demasiado grande o abrumadora: la necesaria limpieza del sótano o la organización semanal de los horarios familiares. Cuando no nos sentimos calificados, no queremos hacer el trabajo. Nos quedamos atrapados en nuestro propio miedo. Ese es el lugar de nacimiento de la procrastinación, la duda y la amargura. Cuando miramos hacia adentro a nuestras propias habilidades, sólo alcanzamos a ver todos los rasgos que justamente no están allí. No vemos la inteligencia, la destreza, la ambición: lo que sea que nos falte y nos quedamos atascados en eso. Tengo buenas noticias y malas noticias. Comenzaré con las malas noticias: ninguno de nosotros está calificado para el llamado del discipulado. Simplemente no lo somos. No tenemos el amor, la gracia o la fuerza para hacer el trabajo. Ahora le daré las buenas noticias: Dios lo sabe y no le importa. La corresponsabilidad no insiste en que poseamos todas las buenas cualidades; no, como forma de vida, la corresponsabilidad reconoce que nos faltan muchas cualidades. Pero nos muestra dónde encontrar el amor, la gracia y la fuerza que necesitamos. La corresponsabilidad no exige que sepamos todas las respuestas; simplemente nos recuerda a quién preguntar cuando no lo hacemos. —Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS



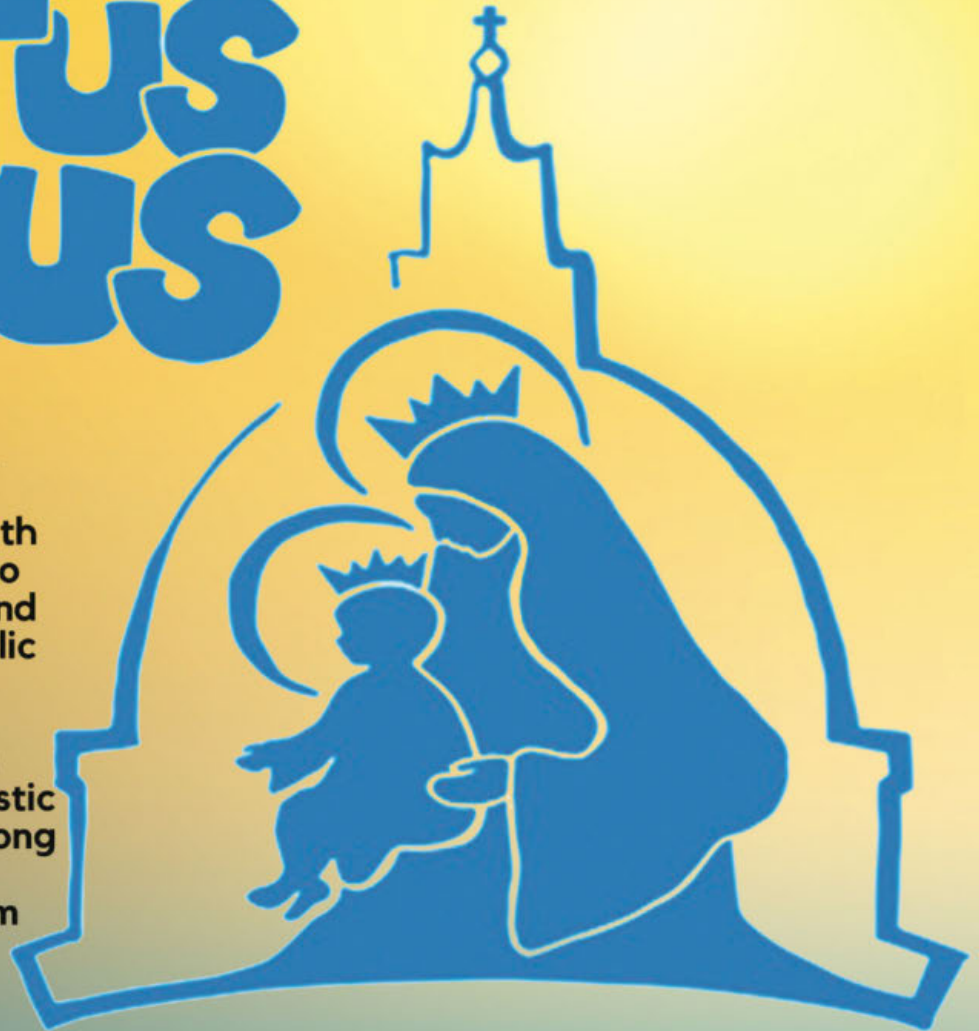

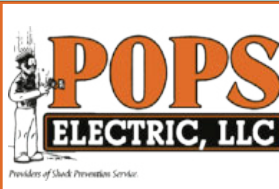
