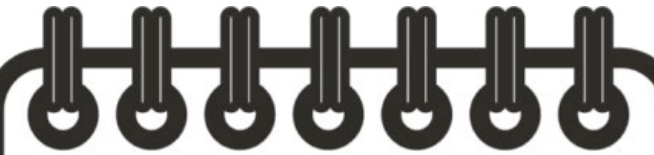


+EVANGELIO: Lc 9, 11-17

SACRED VESSELS

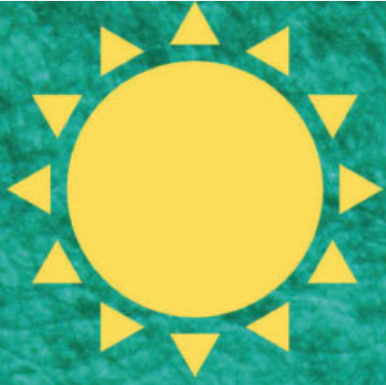
Have you ever paid attention to the purification of the sacred vessels after Holy Communion? If you haven't, I highly recommend doing so this Sunday. See the care with which the priest handles the chalice and the paten, pouring water into them to cleanse any loose particles of the Body and Blood of Christ. Observe the loving reverence he uses in wiping them dry with a special purificator. It's a ritual unto itself, and a powerful moment for reflection. These vessels begin as earthly objects. They are made by human hands. There is nothing special about them — not until they go about the work for which they have been created. Until they contain the Body and Blood of Christ, they are only ordinary objects. But after they have carried within them the Eucharist, they are never the same. They will always be special and deserving of special care. That's why partaking of the Eucharist is, for us, an evangelical undertaking. It is both a transformation and a declaration. When we accept this tremendous gift, we are proclaiming what we believe, and we are accepting the grace to follow through on that commitment. When we are receiving the Eucharist, it is not possible for us to be passive. We become the vessel. We carry Christ into the world with us. But do we act like it? Do we treat ourselves — our bodies, our souls — with the same respect as the priest cleansing the chalice? Do we treat one another with the reverence we would reserve for a sacred object? When we look at another person with anger or irritation or envy, do we acknowledge the change that we have willingly undergone by receiving Christ's Body and Blood into ourselves? — Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS



DEVOTION TO THE SACRED HEART

"Behold," said He to her, "this Heart which has so loved men that it has spared nothing, even to exhausting and consuming itself, in order to testify its love. In return, I receive from the greater part only ingratitude, by their irreverence and sacrilege, and by the coldness and contempt they have for Me in this sacrament of love. And what is most painful to Me," added the Saviour, in a tone that went to the Sister's heart, "is that they are hearts consecrated to Me." Then He commanded her to have established in the Church a particular feast to honor His Sacred Heart. "It is for this reason I ask thee that the first Friday after the octave of the Blessed Sacrament be appropriated to a special feast, to honor My Heart by communicating on that day, and making reparation for the indignity that it has received. And I promise that My Heart shall dilate to pour out abundantly the influences of its love on all that will render it this honor or procure its being rendered." This was the last revelation, and the most celebrated of all. Justly the most celebrated, for all that regards the Divine Heart of Jesus is contained in it. Its principle is no other than the overflowing love of God, love making a grand effort to overcome evil; its end, to become a public devotion, having been so long a private one; and, lastly, its effects, a new effusion of divine love on the Church, and more particularly on the pious souls that become its apostles and propagators.

VASOS SAGRADOS

¿Alguna vez ha prestado atención a la purificación de los vasos sagrados después de la Sagrada Comunión? Si no lo ha hecho, le recomiendo que lo haga este domingo. Observe el cuidado con que el sacerdote manipula el cáliz y la patena, echándoles agua para limpiar las partículas sueltas del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Observe la reverencia amorosa que usa al secarlos con un purificador especial. Es un ritual en sí mismo y un momento poderoso para la reflexión. Estos vasos comienzan siendo objetos terrenales. Están hechos por manos humanas. No tienen nada de especial, hasta que realizan el trabajo para el que fueron creados. Hasta que no contengan el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, son sólo objetos ordinarios. Luego de haber llevado dentro de ellos la Eucaristía, ya no son los mismos. Se convierten en especiales y merecedores de un cuidado especial. Por eso, participar de la Eucaristía es para nosotros una empresa evangélica. Es a la vez una transformación y una declaración. Cuando aceptamos este tremendo regalo, estamos proclamando lo que creemos y estamos aceptando la gracia de cumplir con ese compromiso. Cuando recibimos la Eucaristía, no es posible ser pasivos. Nos convertimos en recipientes. Llevamos a Cristo al mundo con nosotros. Pero, ¿actuamos como tales? ¿Nos tratamos a nosotros mismos, a nuestros cuerpos, a nuestras almas, con el mismo respeto que el sacerdote que limpia el cáliz? ¿Nos tratamos unos a otros con la reverencia que reservaríamos para un objeto sagrado? Cuando miramos a otra persona con ira, irritación o envidia, ¿reconocemos el cambio que hemos experimentado voluntariamente al recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo en nosotros? —Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS

DEVOCIÓN AL SAGRADO CORAZÓN

“He aquí”, le dijo Él, “este Corazón que tanto ha amado a los hombres, que no ha escatimado nada, hasta agotarse y consumirse, para testimoniar su amor. Y lo que más me duele -añadió el Salvador con un tono que llegaba al corazón de la Hermana- es que son corazones a Mí consagrados. Entonces le mandó que estableciera en la Iglesia una fiesta particular para honrar Su Sagrado Corazón. “Por eso te pido que el primer viernes después de la octava del Santísimo Sacramento sea destinado a una fiesta especial, para honrar Mi Corazón comulgando en ese día, y reparando la indignidad que ha recibido. Y prometo que Mi Corazón se dilatará para derramar abundantemente las influencias de su amor sobre todo lo que le rinda este honor o le procure ser rendido.” Esta fue la última revelación, y la más célebre de todas. Con justicia la más célebre, pues en ella está contenido todo lo que se refiere al Divino Corazón de Jesús. Su principio no es otro que el amor desbordante de Dios, amor que hace un gran esfuerzo para vencer el mal; su fin, convertirse en devoción pública, habiendo sido durante tanto tiempo privada; y, finalmente, sus efectos, una nueva efusión del amor divino sobre la Iglesia, y más particularmente sobre las almas piadosas que se convierten en sus apóstoles y propagadores. 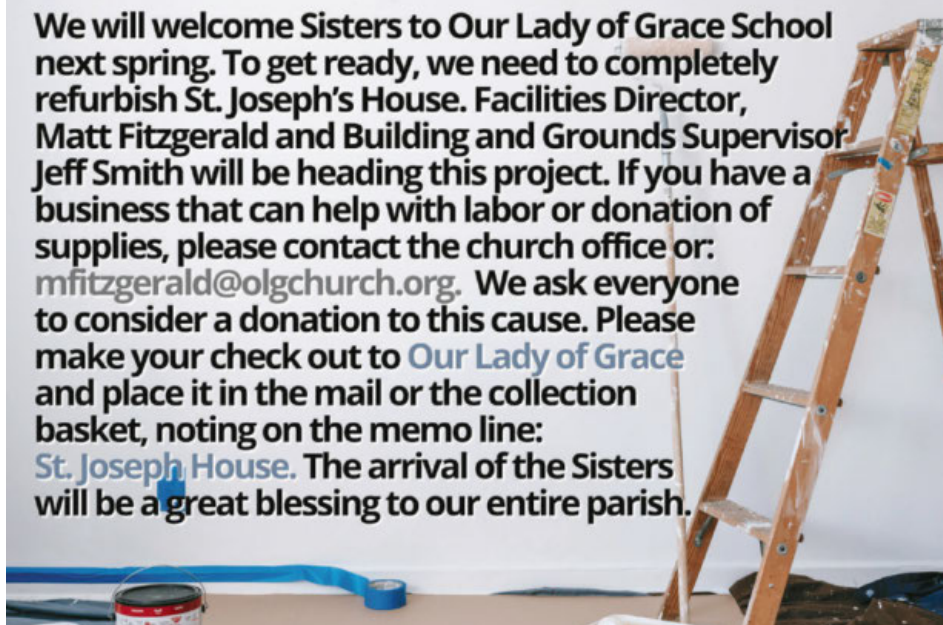

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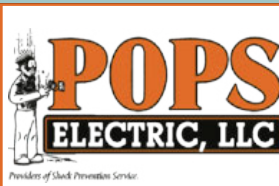
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
