Please remember any person can bid on the quilt. The person with the highest bid will win the quilt and pay the amount of their bid.





GOSPEL MEDITATION ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

January 16, 2022, 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time
