

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,


For my bulletin article this week, I want to focus on two things that are coming up in the life of the Church. Back in December, a letter was read at all of the Masses as well as sent out about the universal Church engaging in what is called a synodal process. Bishop Duca stated in his letter that this process is a “way in which decisions are made that involves listening to a broad range of the faithful and discussing issues that impact the Church and the World constantly open to the Holy Spirit’s call for direction and action.” These types of discussions are happening on a local, regional, national, and international level. For our diocese, they will be approaching the local gatherings at a deanery level. Our deanery’s listening session will be next Thursday, January 20<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. at St. Margaret in Albany. All are welcome to attend. These sessions are not about changing Church doctrine or teaching but how we as a Church could better approach spreading the Word of God, ministering better to parishioners and those who are estranged from the faith, and engaging our communities and society. I am sure many of you have ideas and this listening session would be a great venue to share. If you have any questions, please let me know.

The second thing coming up in the Church is Word of God Sunday. In 2019, Pope Francis instituted this special celebration each year on the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time to encourage Catholics in their use, study, and prayer of the Sacred Scriptures. Pope Francis in his Apostolic Letter that instituted this celebration states, “We should never take God’s word for granted, but instead let ourselves be nourished by it, in order to acknowledge and live fully our relationship with him and with our brothers and sisters.” This is one of the reasons since arriving at Immaculate Conception that I have encouraged you to bring your bibles to Mass. I know it is strange to hear this request coming from a Catholic priest but we, as Catholics, need to do a better job of reading the Bible regularly and praying with it. By no means am I a scripture scholar, but I need to be reading and praying with it more! So, I am encouraging everyone to please bring your Bible next weekend, have it marked for the Mass readings, and try to use it during Mass to follow the readings and help keep you focused.

Finally, thank you to all who prayed for me while I was gone on vacation last week. It was relaxing and a much needed break after a busy Advent and Christmas season! However, it is good to be back home. Please know of my prayers for you and keep praying for me and Fr. Taylor.


Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

January 16, 2022 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

God delights in you. How do you feel when you hear that? Delight usually comes with an exuberant flow of joy that seemingly arises from one’s toes with the expression of great glee. Reflecting upon the deep measure of joy God has in us can be a source of joy for ourselves. Delight is infectious. A very young brother and sister were playing on the beach when the all too familiar ice cream truck made its daily rounds. The boy shook with excitement and delight as he took his sister’s hand and exclaimed, “The ice cream man is here, isn’t it great!” As they ran off toward the truck, one could hear the girl reply, “Yeah, I can’t wait!” The experience of a child’s delight in something so simple as ice cream, lifts our spirits from our burdens and transports us to the lighter, more innocent side of life.

Life is not meant to be a burden. Believe it or not, God actually wants us to be happy! In fact, the wedding feast at Cana shows us that God even puts His blessing on our happiness. It is okay to celebrate the wonder of ourselves and others. Life is good. It is always interesting to note that Jesus saves the good wine until last. You would think it would be the other way around. The superb quality of Jesus’ wine points to the superior quality of life we find in Christ. It is not a life of burdens but a life of wonder and delight! In Christ, we are lifted from the superficial and mundane to a life of purpose, hope, and love.

God is with us through the long haul, through the challenges and sorrows as well as the successes and accomplishments. In spite of the fact that we often wander from the path, God’s celebratory delight in us remains. As spouses are asked to remain faithful to each other through whatever life brings, God remains faithful too. This promise remains through this life and into the next. All we have to do is take the advice of Jesus’ mother to heart when she says, “Listen to him.” This wisdom saves us from foolishly giving in to the illusion that we can make better wine than Jesus.


