My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

What I am about to ask you might seem like a strange question to ask already; however, have you started to think about what your focus for Lent will be? You might be saying to yourself after reading that, “Father, we just left the Christmas season, and now with the restarting of school, activities and still dealing with this pandemic, it is just too much to even think about Lent!” Well, I think it is even more important then to do so! In that hypothetical statement above, the focus is completely on the world. Also, I didn’t say anything about giving up stuff or adding anything to your schedule. My invitation to you is to start having that conversation in your prayer and even with others around you; what should be the focus of your upcoming Lent.

This idea is already on my heart for several reasons. The first is, due to the fact that the staff here at Immaculate Conception have been meeting to finalize plans of what we, as a parish, will provide for Lent and encourage people to do. The second and more personal reason is because of the Christmas season. At Christmas, we celebrated that the Light of the World has come as had been foretold through the prophets. I was also reminded, as we celebrated the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, that the very same light came into my life on the day of my baptism (October 25, 1981). As I bring this to prayer regularly, I realize that I do not allow the Light to fully be a part of my life; I fail to follow that Light in the way that I should. Thus, I know there are things that I need to change in my life to be more open to guidance and direction from the Light of the World. This is why I asked the question at the beginning of my article on the focus of Lent for this coming year.

May I invite you this coming week to take some time in prayer and start having that conversation with the Lord, what are you being invited to focus on this Lent? Remember, you are walking with the Lord to grow closer to Him! If you have good friends that you regularly discuss your faith with, discuss with them the ideas that have come up and see if they have started the same process. Possible areas to consider are: addressing a particular vice, choosing a virtue to grow in, beginning a new daily religious practice, using the Bible in your daily prayer, using devotionals such as the rosary or chaplets, reducing the amount of screen time, increasing times of silence. I could continue with things to consider but I think this is a good start.

Please know that I will be offering up time in my prayer to lift all of you up as we draw closer to Lent and begin the reflection on what to focus on. I ask you kindly to do the same for me, Fr. Taylor, and Blair.

# STUMP THE DEACON!



*In December, Bishop Duca indicated that our diocese would participate in the Church’s synodal process of gathering information for the universal Church by hosting dialogue sessions at our local deaneries. What is a deanery?*

At the present time, our Diocese has 64 Church parishes. Communication and cooperation between 64 different entities, as well as over 100 priests, would be very difficult, so under canon law, the bishop has the ability to group parishes into regional areas called deaneries. Our bishop has formed five deaneries: Baton Rouge Deanery, East Central Deanery, Northeast Deanery, Northwest Deanery and the South Deanery.

Our parish is part of the Northeast Deanery, which includes:

- Holy Ghost, Hammond
- Immaculate Conception, Denham Springs
- Mater Dolorosa, Independence
- Our Lady of Pompeii, Tickfaw
- St. Albert the Great, Hammond
- St. Helena, Amite
- St. Joseph, Ponchatoula
- St. Margaret, Queen of Scotland, Albany

Each deanery is lead by a dean. His main task is to support the priests in his deanery, as well as acting as a liaison between his deanery and the bishop. Rev. Reuben Dykes, the pastor of Mater Dolorosa is the dean of our deanery.

Our deanery meeting requested by Bishop Duca will be held on Thursday, January 20th at 6pm at St. Margaret’s.


