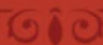

## Second Collections

A special collection will be taken next weekend, **January 14th & 15th**, for two nationally recognized education programs for children with special needs. Both of these institutions are located in the Diocese of Pittsburgh.

**The DePaul School for Hearing and Speech** provides Listening and Spoken Language education to children who are deaf or hard of hearing. Without the use of sign language, DePaul students learn to listen and speak and successfully transition to their neighborhood schools with their typically hearing peers.

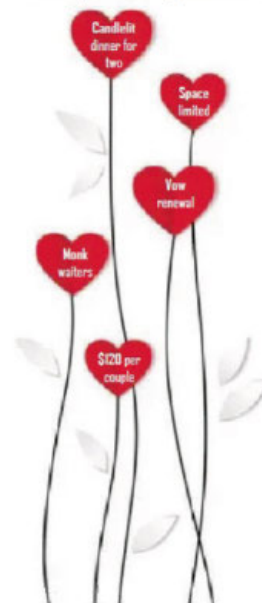

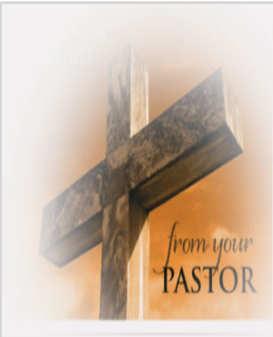

### *St. Vincent de Paul Year-End Overview*

For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, the Fatima SVdP team received \$24,773 from our generous parishioners. Overall, the team performed 1,152 hours of service to 174 families, totaling 325 people. Your monthly envelope contributions, poor box donations and ad-hoc donations made all of this possible. 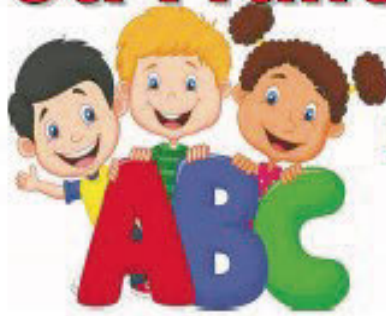

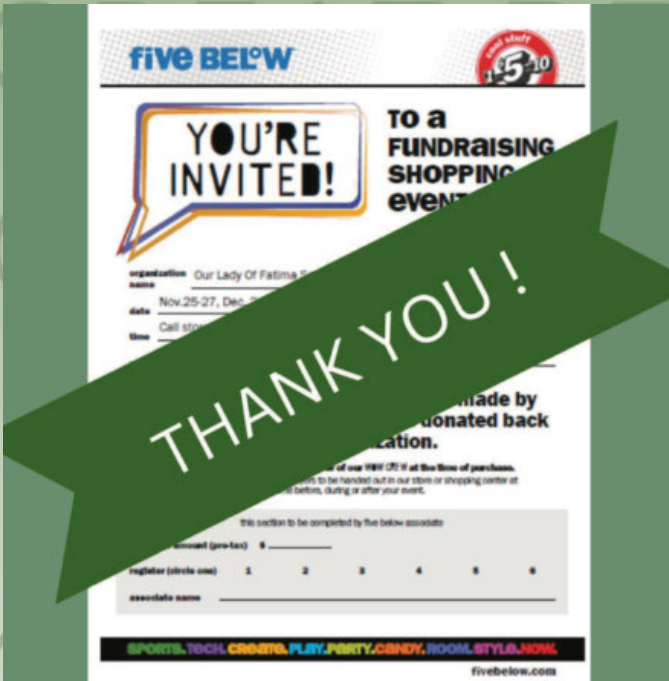
