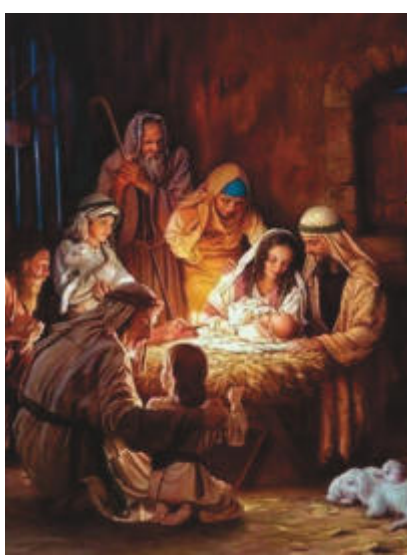


ST. JOSEPH PARISH MISSION

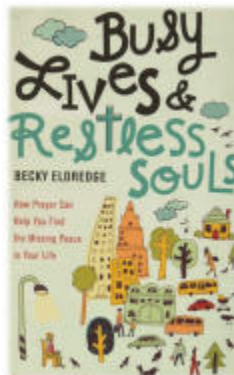
Gift Bags for each St. Joseph Family

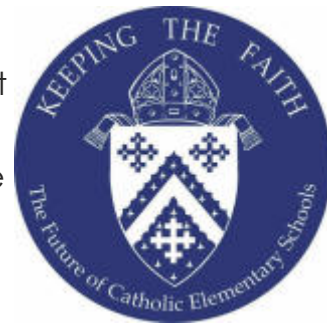

St. Vincent de Paul Society

Throughout 2021 the St. Vincent de Paul conference here at St. Joseph continued to minister to those in our parish community facing financial hardships. The generous support of our parishioners (that's you!) has allowed us to distribute over \$28,000 in aid to those who sought help. Your generosity has kept the lights on, the heat and air conditioning working, and the water running for more than 60 families in our neighborhoods. This includes over \$7,500 in rent and/or mortgage payments, helping those families to remain in their homes.

As 2022 approaches our focus remains the same: to meet with those in need and share the love of Christ through visitation, prayer, and financial assistance. We are always looking for new members! Over 200 Prayer Shawls & Blankets have been made and given to infants, children, adults and the elderly. Good Neighbors, the Falls Cancer Club, Cuyahoga Falls Schools, and area nursing homes have given out ministry's shawls and blankets, as well as agencies that serve our local veterans, the homeless, and women in need with children. Meetings are on the first Tuesday of the month from 6:30-8:30pm in the Nazareth Room, in Jones Hall (School Gym bldg.). During meetings, we pray for the recipient throughout the entire assembly. When completed, shawls and blankets are washed, placed in a plastic bag, then blessed by Father or Deacon. Materials and instruction are provided at the meetings. She agreed, but due to a recent long illness and her transition to retirement at the end of December and the training of her replacement, she has not yet begun her mission. However, once she meets with the committee, she has big plans for 2022 and beyond. Plans include parish participation in the Akron area March for Life in January, along with joining with churches across the county in the annual signature media campaign to help provide life saving resources to abortion minded individuals. Other long range plans are conducting sidewalk counseling classes at the parish to encourage witnessing at the Cuyahoga Falls abortion clinic, and a future parish meeting to discuss end-of-life issues and planning. As we reflect on this past year, we are grateful to everyone who has donated their time on behalf of St. Joseph Parish CYO. Our coaches and board members as well as Parish and School leadership have been instrumental in navigating the uncertainties of 2021 to provide athletic opportunities for more than 100 student-athletes. Thank you to our parents and especially our student-athletes who have demonstrated good sportsmanship and teamwork on the court, field and race path. Below are just a few Falcontastic highlights from the fall and winter seasons:

- Our fall service project involved student-athletes in grades 1-8 and created 60 care packages for people experiencing homelessness.
- Flag football returned to St. Joseph after a several year hiatus with a combined 3rd/4th grade boys team.
- For the first time in history, St. Joseph sponsored a 1st-3rd grade girls cheerleading squad.
- Our 6th grade girls volleyball team ended the regular season 5-3.
- Our 4th grade boys basketball team is undefeated heading into week 3 and our 5th grade boys team was runner-up in the Classic at the Castle tourney and has a 5-1 record.
