# From the Pastor's Desk

Merry Christmas!

I hope you are having an excellent Christmas Season as we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph today. The Christmas Season continues until the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on January 10th. Will you be able to keep the decorations in place until then as we observe some important feasts which warrant joyful celebration? Some places will even keep their Christmas decorations in place for a full 40 days until the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2nd.

This week, on the Octave Day of Christmas, January 1st, we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. This is normally a holy day of obligation, but because of the pandemic, we are dispensed from the obligation to participate in Mass here in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. For the solemnity, we will have a Mass schedule that is very similar to our current weekend schedule, but without Mass on Friday evening:

- Thursday at 4:30 PM
- Friday at 8:00 AM, 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM

Most of us are familiar with the old Christmas carol "The Twelve Days of Christmas" about receiving gifts until the feast of Epiphany. In some places of the world, in other times, the feast of Epiphany was celebrated with much more solemnity and gift giving than Christmas was. It is a celebration and an imitation of the gifts the Magi gave to the Infant Jesus. Until recent decades, Epiphany was observed on January 6th. Now, it is one of those feasts that gets transferred to a Sunday. So, this year, Epiphany will be observed on January 3rd. As usual, blessed chalk will be available to the faithful who would like to administer the Epiphany blessing in their homes.





## St. Vincent de Paul Thanksgiving Basket Recap

Unfortunately, because of the restrictions put in place for public health safety due to the Covid-19 virus, our Thanksgiving Basket project had to be modified this Fall. Rather than taking in food donations as we have in the past and then assembling and delivering a complete Thanksgiving meal to those in need, our St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) team had to ask parishioners to donate Kroger and Meijer food gift cards this year.

Because of the tremendous generosity of our parishioners, we collected over \$6000.00 in Kroger and Meijer gift card donations. Our SVdP team was able to meet the needs of our clients as well as local programs that we have helped in the past.

We delivered gift cards to each recipient to buy a large and complete Thanksgiving meal from Kroger or Meijer food stores, as well as supporting local poorer parishes and resources in our area; such as the Kings Mill Food Pantry, Prince of Peace Church Food Pantry, and the NorthStar Church Outreach Program. Additionally, we were able to provide gift cards needed to purchase Christmas meals for these client families.

with an increased number of men who have been ordained to the priesthood in the past few years or who are currently in seminary formation, we have even more still serving as pastors who are at or beyond retirement age or who will be eligible to retire in the next few years. We must address this situation through thoughtful strategic and pastoral planning in order to form vital parishes that lead us all to embrace Christ and the call to missionary discipleship.<sup>1</sup>

Beacons of Light will be a unique experience of pastoral planning for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. 


