Epiphany House Blessing Prayer

Epiphany celebrates the joyous truth that God calls into relationship with Himself not only the chosen people of Israel, but the entire world. Families have traditionally “marked” this truth by the practice of “chalking” the front door of their homes at Epiphany. This visible mark on your door reminds your family, friends and guests that you hope they will find Christ in your home, just as did the Magi who followed the star to Bethlehem.

Here’s how it works:

Using the chalk blessed at Church, your family writes the numerals for the New Year over or on your front door. In the middle of the numerals, add the initials “CMB.” Tradition suggests that this comes from the Latin blessing, *Christus mansionem benedicat*, “May Christ bless this home.” These are also the initials of the three wise men, known to us as Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. Both interpretations remind us of God’s generous gift of gracing us with his presence.

Here’s the ritual to be prayed together as a family. You’ll need a Bible and the chalk blessed at Mass. All make the Sign of the Cross.

The leader begins:

Leader: Let us praise God, who fills our hearts and homes with peace. Blessed be the name of the Lord.

All: Now and forever.

Leader: After the Lord Jesus was born in Bethlehem, Magi from the east followed a star to Bethlehem where they found the new-born child and worshipped him. Mary and Joseph cared for Jesus and watched over him as he grew. As a man, Jesus preached about God’s love for all, He favored the poor, healed the sick, and welcomed the children. He suffered and died for us and God raised him from the dead. He is here with us. Let us make our home a place of welcome and peace where all can see the goodness of Christ. Let us make our home a dwelling place of love. Let us pray: Gracious God, as a shining star once guided the Magi to the birthplace of the infant Jesus, help us who dwell here to be your light in the world. We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

The Gospel (and additional readings) for Epiphany may now be read by a family member: (Matthew 2:1-12, Isaiah 60:1-6, Psalm 72, or Ephesians 3:2-6).

At the entrance of the home and with hands joined, the leader prays:

Leader: Lord God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who live here. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our concern for others may reflect your love. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

Family members then chalk the door with the inscription: 20+C+M+B+22

After which the leader concludes by inviting everyone to say the Our Father. Have a Blessed New Year!



From the Pastor's Desk

Merry Christmas!

Thank you very much for your Christmas greetings, treats and prayers!

The Christmas Season continues until the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord next weekend. In fact, some of the faithful will practice some aspects of Christmas and Epiphany all the way up until the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2nd.

Because of scheduling conflicts, I am going to share my 90 Days in Spain in 90 Minutes presentation on Friday, January 28th at 7:00 PM. One question that might come up is: What is a sabbatical? Here is a short reflection as a teaser:

The word "sabbatical" is related to the word "sabbath" which means rest. So, does this mean that a sabbatical is just time off work, or is there more to it? My plan was to study the Spanish language and the spirituality of St. Josemaría Escrivá while experiencing the Catholic culture of Spain. I did not know exactly what else to expect, but I quickly realized my sabbatical was time away from my normal ministry but made time for another ministry. I noticed I was still practicing spiritual fatherhood, just with spiritual sons and daughters in a different part of the world. I offered Mass every day, kept up my prayer commitments and heard confessions at the university and the residence. Since I stayed at a house of formation for men who are studying philosophy and planning to enter seminary, I tried to present myself as a witness to the vocation of priesthood. Since it was not vacation and I would be in the presence of the faithful every day, I was sure to present myself as for ministry every day by staying clean shaven and wearing black, for example. It was still ministry, just a different kind. And ministry in the vineyard of the Lord is always fulfilling.

Thanks for your prayers. Be assured of my daily prayers for you.

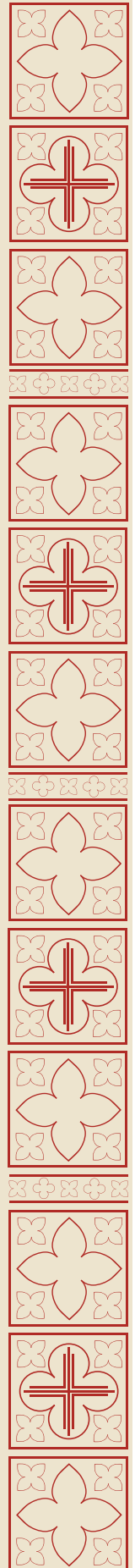

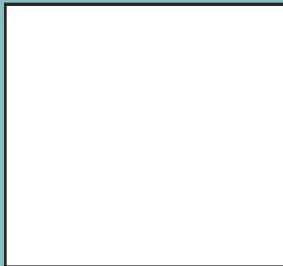
