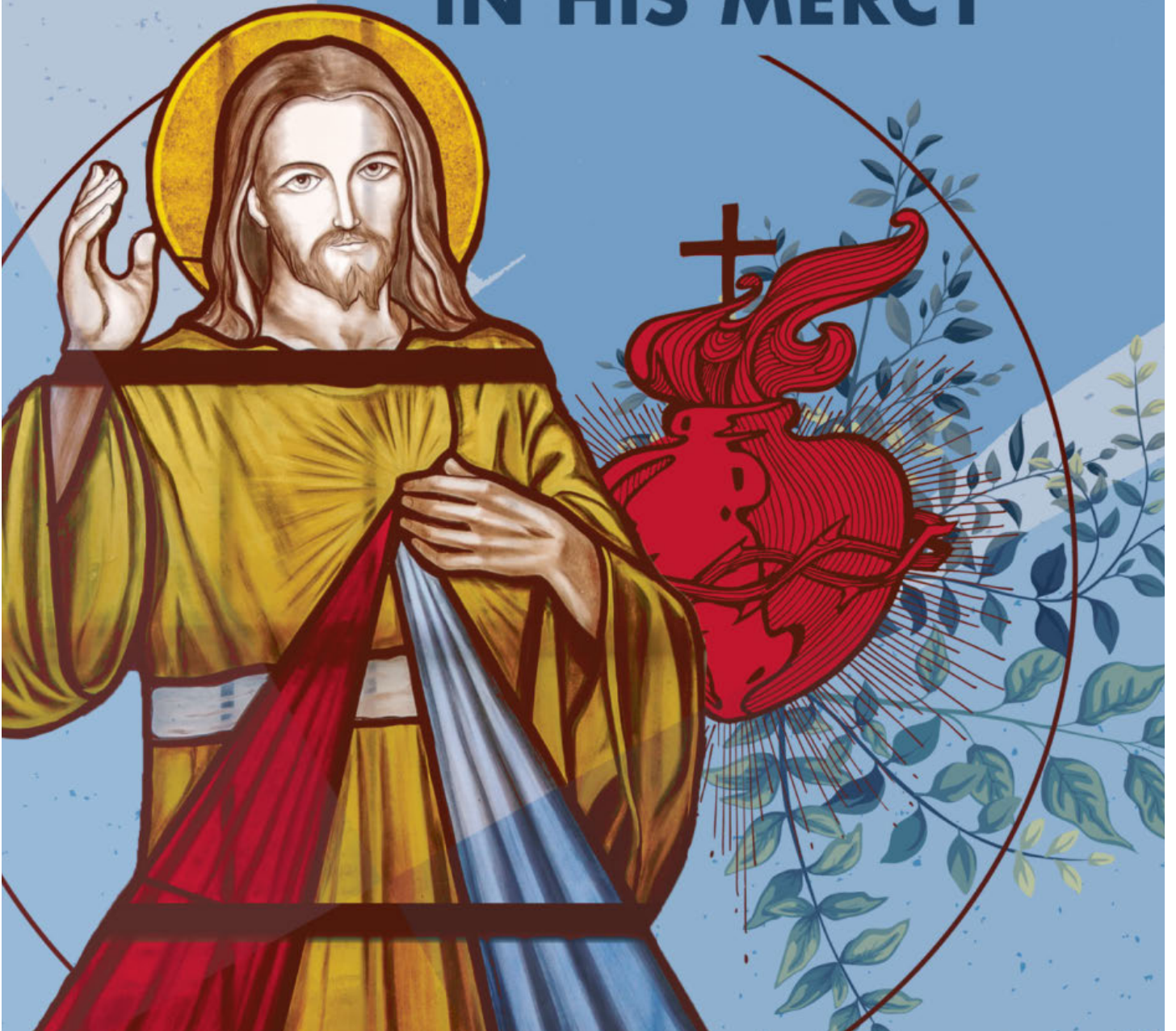

From the Pastor's Desk

Fr. Bedel

Beloved in Christ,

Please plan to bring the family back for the Divine Mercy celebration this afternoon. Information is in this bulletin.

Please keep our eighth graders in your prayers. They will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation this Tuesday, which gives them the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, the grace of the sacrament and the indelible character of Confirmation. Notice how these gifts allow them to begin to truly learn the Faith. Yes, begin. The worst thing we could do is treat the Sacrament of Confirmation as a kind of graduation from learning the Faith and never use the gifts given and never unpack the richness that has been given to us. It is incumbent on the faithful, especially their parents, to guide these confirmandi deeper into the truths of Jesus Christ with this new wisdom, understanding and maturity.

Why are there kneelers in the middle of the church? First, let me say that no one is required to use a kneeler. In fact, you are not even invited nor encouraged to use a kneeler. But they are there for your use if you so choose. Use for what? For several months, multiple parishioners have been asking for kneelers for receiving Holy Communion. I took the idea to parish council, and they advised me that we should provide the kneelers. They pointed out that our neighbor, St. Susanna, and many other parishes provide kneelers for those who wish to use them.

Even though the ordinary, world-wide practice of receiving Holy Communion is to receive on the tongue while standing, other options are also legitimate. For example, the United States and some other countries have a dispensation, or permission, to receive in the hand. It is also perfectly legitimate to receive Holy Communion while kneeling. So, those who want to can use the kneelers. Those who stand can simply walk up to the priest or deacon at the kneeler and receive as usual. Notice that even though we have several lines for communion, we only have two kneelers. That means those who want to use

them will have to get in the lines where the kneelers are.

Since I was advised by parish council, I have been praying over a time to introduce them. I thought: How about the day when we commemorate Jesus instituting the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper? So, Holy Thursday was the day. In His providence, I received this in an email earlier in Holy Week: "The Church dedicates the month of April to the Most Blessed Sacrament. Holy Church is the guardian of the Holy Eucharist. For two thousand years, she has guarded this treasure, administering it to the faithful and proclaiming that it is nothing less than Jesus himself. We can never be too devoted to the Blessed Sacrament or show it too much honor."

Totus Tuus

Totus Tuus, Latin for "Totally Yours," is a week-long summer catechetical youth program that combines Catholic religious instruction and having fun! A team of college-age students and seminarians come to the parish to lead. The youthfulness and energy of the teachers is an inspiring way to share the faith and their enthusiasm is contagious, so come out and join us. The day includes catechetical instruction on our theme - the Virtues and Beatitudes and Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary, songs, and skits that are silly but teach the faith, encounters with the sacraments, particularly Confession and the Eucharist, and time for games and recess. For teens, those entering 7 - 12 grades, a teen program of Totus Tuus covers more in-depth discussions on our theme and is held in the evening. **Visit:** smoy.org to register.

Parish Religion Program

REGISTRATION IS OPEN!

The St. Margaret of York Catholic Church Parish Religion Program assists the parents (the primary catechists) in the faith formation of their children to know, love, and serve Jesus.

All parish children in grades 1-8 are expected to attend one of the following:

- Online PRP
- Sunday PRP, September - April
- Family Faith
- Enrolled in the Parish School

Children are required to have 2 years of religious education to receive a Sacrament. Preparation for Confirmation requires an additional component from our standard religious education programs during the Sacramental year. Any questions or concerns please contact Courtney Brown.

Online PRP

When: Access to Course Content begins in June 2022

Our Online PRP is a flexible program designed to equip parents to thrive in their natural vocation as the first Catechist and teacher of the faith to their children. The curriculum is Ignatius Press Life In Christ but instead of purchasing the physical books, Ignatius Press has partnered with Our Catholic Faith Delivered which allows for a complete, online approach to home study faith formation.

The students have access to their grade level materials online for a 1 year period and have the ability to complete the coursework at their own pace. All assessments and prayer exercises are completed through the online platform so that both the parents and our Faith Formation office can monitor progress in knowledge of the faith and relationship with Christ.

Sunday PRP

When: Sunday Mornings, September 2022 - April 2023

Sunday PRP uses the Graded Course of Study established by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, which encompasses the 7 tasks of catechesis: Prayer, Knowledge of the Faith, Liturgical Life, Moral Formation, Communal Life, Missionary Spirit, and Theology of the Body. Students will have the opportunity to talk about their faith with classmates their own age and with a devoted catechist.

Family Faith

When: 3rd Sunday of Month, September 2022 - April 2023

Family Faith brings St. Margaret of York families together once a month to learn about the life of Jesus Christ, His teachings, our Catholic Faith, and helping families pass on a living faith. At home, parents will foster their relationship with Christ and help their children fall in love with Jesus as they journey toward Heaven as a family. On one Sunday of each month, families meet together to experience our Faith through teaching, discussion, and activities. The discussion and activities are broken up into age groups such as Parents (Adults), High School Age, Jr High Age, Middle School, Primary, and preschool, depending on the number of families who register.

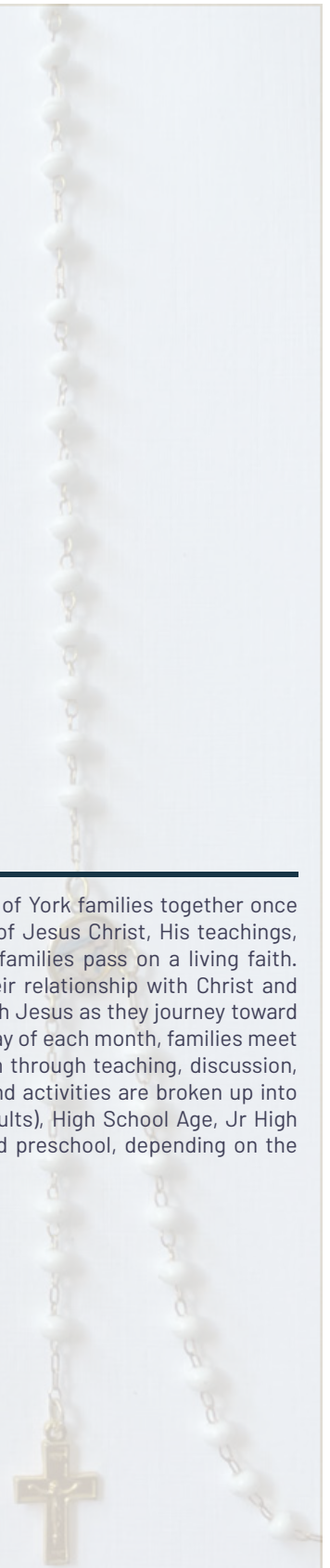
