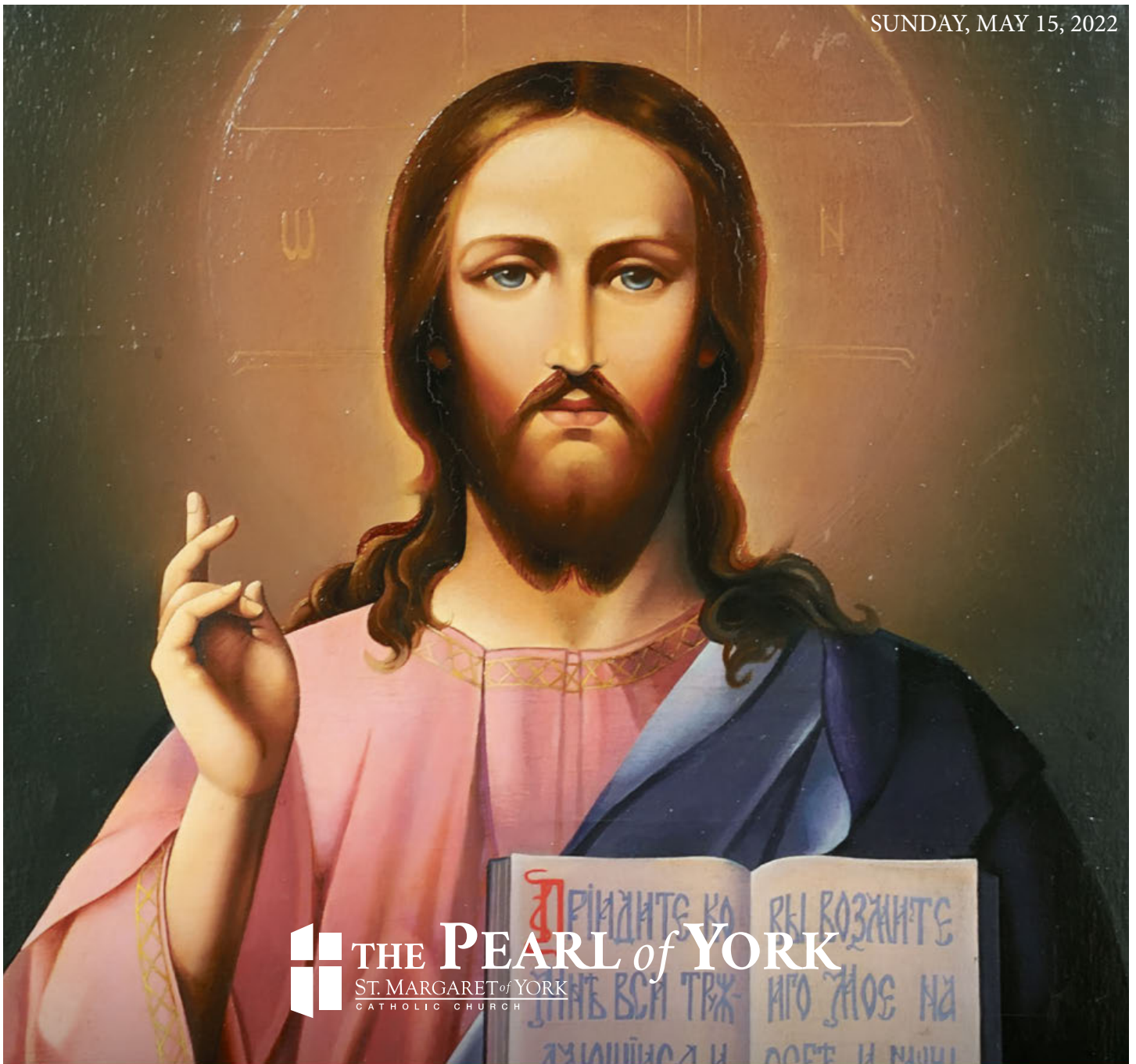

# Meet the Elizabeth Ministry

The mission of the Elizabeth Ministry is to provide care and support to the mothers of new babies in our parish community. Whether they are first-time moms or welcoming their 10th child, we are here to make this blessed time a little easier.

Amy Konrad brought the Elizabeth Ministry to SMOY nine years ago. She provided support for mothers during the beautiful and exhausting time and also helped draw them into our SMOY community. Last summer, Amy asked me to lead the Elizabeth Ministry and I feel grateful to help mothers in the way I was served after my children were born.

Women in the Elizabeth Ministry serve by praying rosaries, knitting and crocheting blankets while praying for the new child, preparing meals for the family, and by providing home visits to help the mother of the new baby. Our home visitors make 6, 2-hour visits and offer whatever help is needed most. We hold babies while mothers nap or shower, we fold laundry, change sheets, clean bathrooms, play with older kids, read to toddlers, empty dishwashers or simply offer a listening ear. These small and meaningful acts, done with loving care, imitate Christ's love.

I was humbled to invite women into my home after having a new baby, but at the end of our six weeks of visits, I felt honored to have met each of the SMOY women who served my family and to see their familiar, smiling faces at Mass! The Elizabeth Ministry has Expectant Mother Blessings three times each year (following a Sunday Mass), for mothers expecting children through birth, foster care, or adoption.

## St. Margaret of Cortona | May 16



Though St. Margaret of Cortona (1247 - 1297) is today known as being an incredibly pious Catholic, she didn't start out that way. Born into a farming family in Laviano, Tuscany, her mother died when St. Margaret was seven. Her father remarried, but life with her stepmother was so difficult that St. Margaret moved out of the home and instead chose to live with a man named Arsenio, though they weren't married. They had been living together for nine years when she gave birth to a son. Knowing in her heart that this wasn't the life that God intended for her to have, she prayed for purity.

One day while waiting for Arsenio, his dog led her into the forest where she found Arsenio murdered. So shocked was St. Margaret that she fell into a life of penance. She and her son returned to Laviano, but still found her stepmother to be as unwelcoming as ever. They then went to Cortona, and eventually her son became a friar.

Three years after her conversion, St. Margaret followed in her son's footsteps and became a Fran-

ciscan tertiary. During her life, St. Margaret established a hospital and founded a congregation of tertiary sisters. She was canonized in 1728.

# Parish Religion Program

## REGISTRATION IS OPEN!

The St. Margaret of York Catholic Church Parish Religion Program assists the parents (the primary catechists) in the faith formation of their children to know, love, and serve Jesus.

All parish children in grades 1-8 are expected to attend one of the following:

- Online PRP
- Sunday PRP, September - April
- Family Faith
- Enrolled in the Parish School

**Children are required to have 2 years of religious education to receive a Sacrament. Preparation for Confirmation requires an additional component from our standard religious education programs during the Sacramental year. Any questions or concerns please contact Courtney Brown.**

### Online PRP

**When:** Access to Course Content begins in June 2022

Our Online PRP is a flexible program designed to equip parents to thrive in their natural vocation as the first Catechist and teacher of the faith to their children. The curriculum is Ignatius Press Life In Christ but instead of purchasing the physical books, Ignatius Press has partnered with Our Catholic Faith Delivered which allows for a complete, online approach to home study faith formation.

The students have access to their grade level materials online for a 1 year period and have the ability to complete the coursework at their own pace. All assessments and prayer exercises are completed through the online platform so that both the parents and our Faith Formation office can monitor progress in knowledge of the faith and relationship with Christ.

### Sunday PRP

**When:** Sunday Mornings, September 2022 - April 2023

Sunday PRP uses the Graded Course of Study established by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, which encompasses the 7 tasks of catechesis: Prayer, Knowledge of the Faith, Liturgical Life, Moral Formation, Communal Life, Missionary Spirit, and Theology of the Body. Students will have the opportunity to talk about their faith with classmates their own age and with a devoted catechist.

### Family Faith

**When:** 3rd Sunday of Month, September 2022 - April 2023

Family Faith brings St. Margaret of York families together once a month to learn about the life of Jesus Christ, His teachings, our Catholic Faith, and helping families pass on a living faith. At home, parents will foster their relationship with Christ and help their children fall in love with Jesus as they journey toward Heaven as a family. On one Sunday of each month, families meet together to experience our Faith through teaching, discussion, and activities. The discussion and activities are broken up into age groups such as Parents (Adults), High School Age, Jr High Age, Middle School, Primary, and preschool, depending on the number of families who register.

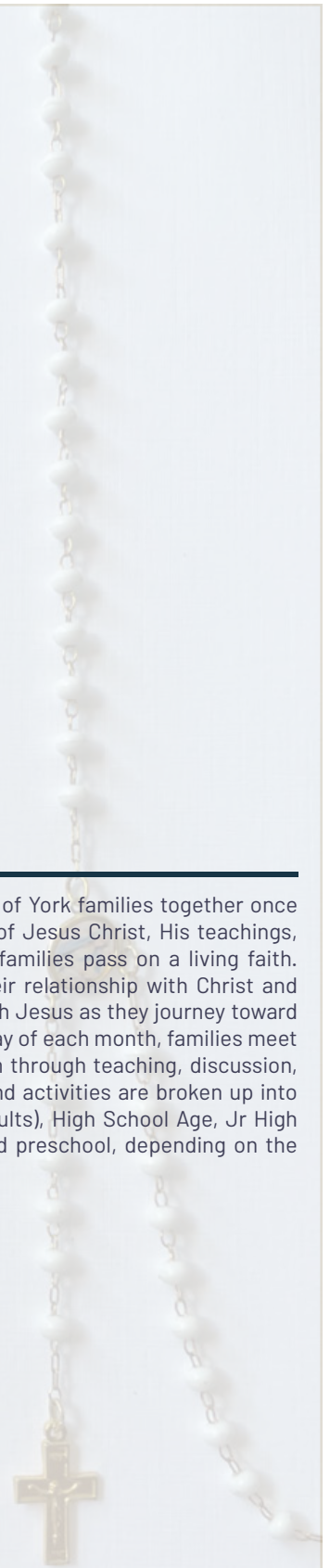

## Everyday Stewardship

### Recognize God in Your Ordinary Moments

#### Reluctant Sheep

Sheep get an awfully bad rap, linguistically. Some are quick to label people as "sheep" if we think they haven't sufficiently questioned authority or if they're too willing to go along with someone else's plan. We say someone has "the wool over their eyes" if they aren't willing to see what we think is very obvious. "A wolf in sheep's clothing" is what we call someone looking to take advantage of those too gullible to identify a real threat.

Taking all this into account and considering how often we are referred to as sheep in Scripture, you've really got to wonder if God is trying to tell us something about ourselves.

If you look at the phraseology associated with sheep, it's no wonder that nobody wants to be one. Sheep are innocent. Sheep can't protect themselves. They're vulnerable and easily misled.

We want to see ourselves as the opposite of all that. We like to think we're shrewd, with plenty of common sense. We want to believe that we don't have to rely on anybody for anything. We would sooner identify with the wolf than with the sheep – at least the wolf can take care of himself.

We do this because we often resist the need to rest in the greatness of God. Like a child walking to school alone for the first time (forgetting his mom is following watchfully in the car), we want to think we can handle it all by ourselves.

The truth is that God is trying to tell us something by comparing us to sheep: You don't have to do this on your own.

Every time I look at an obstacle and think that there is no way around it, I am forgetting that I have a shepherd who knows the location of the gate.

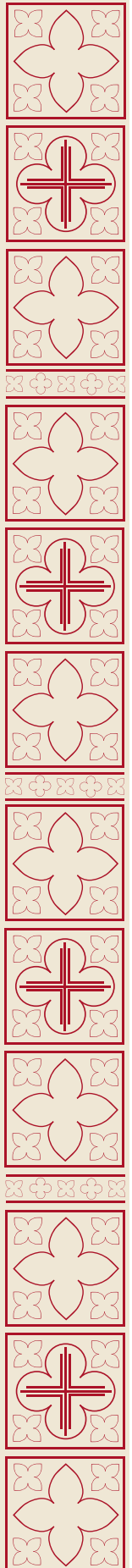

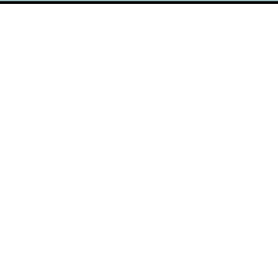

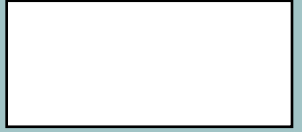
