

15° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Así es, Dios nunca nos pide algo que no podamos hacer. Nuestras manos y corazón están a la medida de lo que se debe de hacer. Aunque, a veces se sienta que no se puede pasar por la experiencia que se vive, Dios da la fuerza y se avanza, muchas veces arriesgando la propia vida. En la primera lectura de este domingo, Dios alienta al pueblo en su travesía por el desierto de la siguiente manera: "Todo lo contrario, mi palabra ha llegado bien cerca de ti; ya la tienes en la boca y sabes de memoria, y solo hace falta ponerla en práctica" (Deuteronomio 30,14); asegurando su cercanía y poniendo en práctica su fe y confianza de lo aprendido de su misma experiencia del camino.

El Papa Francisco, en una de sus tantas catequesis dominicales, nos pide asegurarnos de preguntarnos lo siguiente: ¿Nuestra fe es fecunda? ¿Nuestra fe produce obras buenas? ¿O es más bien estéril, y, por tanto, está más muerta que viva? ¿Me hago prójimo o simplemente paso de largo? La última pregunta de este perfecto examen de conciencia de este domingo del buen samaritano es la siguiente: ¿Soy de aquellos que seleccionan a la gente según su propio gusto? Y, es más, el Papa Francisco recomienda que estas preguntas nos las hagamos frecuentemente, no una vez al día, sino varias veces en la jornada del día. El buen samaritano y el posadero son los ejemplos de este Evangelio. ¿Cuál deseas imitar tú?



Saint of the Week

Saint Henry was born in 972 to Henry, Duke of Bavaria, Germany, and his wife Gisela of Burgundy. Saint Henry's early life was permeated with Christianity, among those who guided his education was Bishop Wolfgang of Ratisbon, who became a saint himself. In 995, Saint Henry succeeded his father as Duke of Bavaria, and in 1002, upon the death of his cousin, Otho III, he was elected emperor. In 1014, Saint Henry undertook the long journey from Germany to Rome to be crowned Holy Roman Emperor by Pope Benedict XIII.

In 1022 Saint Henry assisted Pope Benedict VIII in holding the Council of Pavia, which promoted clerical celibacy and sought to end simony (the buying and selling of ecclesiastical goods and offices). During his reign, Saint Henry used his wealth and position for the Church. He confirmed Benedict's authority over Rome, was a patron of churches and monasteries, supported the Cluniac Reforms, restored episcopal sees, and founded the Diocese of Bamburg where he built a cathedral. Saint Henry was married to Cunigunde of Luxembourg, to whom he was incredibly devoted. Although disputed by some historians, some stories of the couple's marriage report they took vows of chastity because their union was childless. Saint Henry died in July of 1024 and was canonized in 1146 by Pope Eugene III.

Lectio Divina



Question:

What is Lectio Divina, and how is it associated with the Benedictine Monastic tradition, whose founder, St. Benedict, we honor on July 11?

Answer

Benedict desired his monks to live in community, praying the Liturgy of the Hours together, contemplating sacred texts, and doing manual labor. The monks developed a technique to facilitate a spiritual and devotional reading of the Bible known as Lectio Divina, the holy reading of a text. This method encourages the reader to hear the biblical text with an open heart and focus on whatever God wants to highlight and then apply it to daily life.

There are variations on Lectio Divina, but essentially, the technique consists of a three-step process of reflection. When the reflection is done with a group, the responses are shared by all the participants. Once the text is selected, it is read meditatively, and the following are then explored: a word or phrase that attracts you; how and where the content of this reading touches your life today; what you believe that God wants you to do during this coming week (month, year, lifetime).

Thanks to Benedict, the Christian community has been gifted with this special way of entering into the biblical text. This week, use the Lectio Divina process on one of the readings for the coming Sunday and make a note of the life connections you are making. How is this reflection on the biblical text drawing you closer to God and others?

Urgent Prayer Request

Dear Brothers and Sister in Christ and in Domestic Church,

One of the many beautiful ways that the Holy Spirit works through Domestic Church is in bringing our community together in a time of need. Our dear Michael and Erin Franco, who are from Baton Rouge and who currently serve as the Regional Couple for Region 5, which includes the state of Louisiana, are in need of our community's help.

On Thursday, June 16, Michael and two friends (Sean Harrison and Jeffrey Trufant) were flying in a small plane, taking aerial photos of a summer camp in the mountains of North Carolina. Toward the end of their flight, the plane became unresponsive and crashed in a wooded area on the outskirts of the camp. Miraculously, all three survived, though they were all very badly injured. Michael and Sean had to be air -lifted to Greenville Memorial Hospital in South Carolina, and Jeffery is at a hospital in Asheville to be treated for his injuries. Michael suffered a number of severely broken bones and internal injuries, and he now faces a long process of treatment and recovery including multiple reconstructive surgeries. He and Erin have five young children and are expecting their sixth. Michael will be at Greenville Memorial hospital in Greenville, SC, and Erin will be with him for the duration of his stay, which will be until Friday at the earliest. Their five children are at home and being cared for by family and by DC members.

Michael is self-employed, and the financial weight of this tragedy (medical bills and Michael's inability to work) will be a major burden for them. So, please consider a generous gift so they can focus completely on Michael's recovery and the well-being of their family!

Here are two ways to help financially: We have a GoFundMe set up as well as a meal train link. The meal train link starts now in order to aid those who are caring for their children, and our hope is to make it available through when Michael and Erin are home.
