Over the Mountains

We left Orisson the morning of May 1st in cold, light drizzle. As we climbed higher in the mountains I would end up needing every layer I brought...tee shirt, fleece, light jacket, and rain jacket, stocking cap, etc. Halfway up with my hands freezing, I struggled with numb fingers to pull my gloves on. We were shrouded in fog and mystery. Wild horses roamed the fields around us...we could hear the ringing of cow bells. It was a tough ascent. We arrived at the snow level, and then walked through a lovely leaf covered path in the woods, that suddenly turned to guick sand and threatened to soak our feet in mud. (I said a silent prayer of thanks for my hiking boots, just high enough to keep the mud out.) The descent was even more rigorous as we crossed into Spain, following in the footsteps of Roland, Charlemagne, and so many others. Our very steep descent through a large Beech forest (our cab driver had warned us not to take it!), included a stop for lunch where the sun broke out for a few moments. I wrote in my journal: "Crossed Pyrenees—cold wind, rain, very exhilarating... feel it in my body today, much gratitude."


