During December 2018 we provided food and utilities assistance each Tuesday and Thursday for six (6) service days for a total of 223 households and 547 individuals. No distribution made on Snow Day nor Christmas. Utilities assistance was provided to 46 people, for a total of \$1,888.49. A total of 11,460 lbs of food was picked up from partner stores and received from in-kind donations. Your weekly donations of dry goods (mac & cheese, peanut butter, CEREAL, pasta, canned goods, etc) continues to be a major source. No glass jars please. Clean plastic and especially brown paper shopping bags are also needed.
