Reporting Child Sexual Abuse and Sexual Harassment

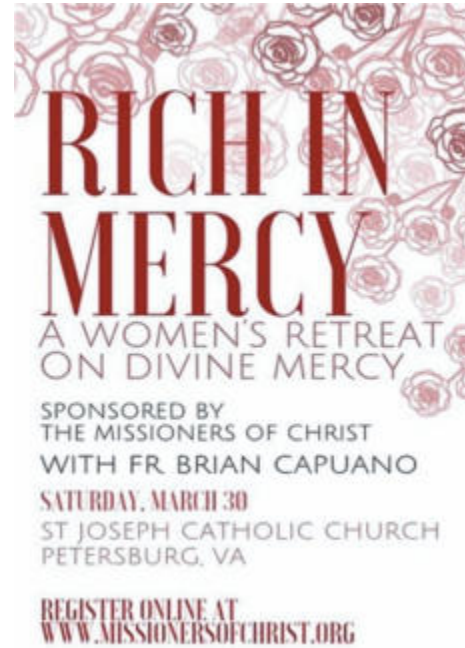
