## Lenten Fasting and Abstinence

**Fasting** is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

**Abstinence** is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

## Hope Center Update:

During February 2019 we provided food and utilities assistance each Tuesday and Thursday for eight (8) service days for a total of 327 households and 858 individuals. This was a record month for distributing food. Utilities assistance was provided to 38 people, for a total of \$1,646. A total of 15,310 lbs of food was picked up from partner stores and received from in-kind donations. Your weekly donations of dry goods (mac & cheese, peanut butter, jelly, CEREAL, pasta, sauce, canned veggies, etc) continues to be a major source. No glass jars please.
