Mike Brown, who has brought hundreds of people into the Catholic faith through his RCIA classes at Prince of Peace, has retired from the church office staff. He became part-time director of adult formation in 2010 and in this capacity also offered adult faith formation classes on Tuesdays and

Sundays. These popular classes encompassed a wide range of topics from Bible studies to interfaith dialogues, social issues and Church history. Mike and his wife Joanie have supported the church's adult formation program for a total of 27 years, coordinating the RCIA program from 1993 through 2020.

It was Fr. John Fallon who convinced Mike to join the church staff after he retired as administrator of the UAB Civitan International Research Center. Our pastor was inspired by the Vatican II Declaration on Christian Education to offer the parish opportunities for a lifetime of faith formation. Mike was well qualified to do just that with BA and MA degrees from Aquinas Institute of Theology and an MBA from the University of New Mexico.

Although officially retired, Mike has volunteered to continue to offer his well-loved Sunday and Tuesday adult study programs at Prince of Peace. Dr. Dale Wisely has assumed responsibility for adult faith formation at Prince of Peace, becoming Director of Adult Education and Family Life.

Mercy is the Heart of God

What a wonderful joy fills us today as we ponder the inexhaustible mercy of God. "Mercy is the heart of God," Pope Francis tells us. The image of a heart has been used to point to the very life source of a person as it is the organ that allows life to flow through our veins and sustain us. Mercy is the heart of God. Imagine this dynamic, powerful, compassionate, piercing, embracing, loving, propelling, penetrating, absorbing, and enveloping, transforming presence of God flowing into the very depth of our souls. It is God's mercy that allows blood to flow through our veins. It is God's mercy that forms every atom of our being and leads us to what is true. God's mercy reveals all superficiality and falsehood, and lays bare all distortions, empty promises, weakness, and sin.

"Mercy is the force that reawakens us to new life and instills in us the courage to look to the future with hope," Pope Francis continues. God's all-forgiving, compassionate love is with us. When we finally believe and accept that Christ's resurrected transfigured presence resides with us, we then find within us a strong confidence to accept life's imperfections and disappointments and move on. Every day is a new adventure in new life. God leaves the past behind and opens doors to the future. It doesn't matter how many mistakes we made yesterday. All that matters is what we do tomorrow and what we learn along the way. It is so easy to remain tethered and mired in the past, but there is no need to do so. God is all about tomorrow and the work God has yet to do in our lives.

Mercy gives birth to hope. Hope for the greatest of sinners and hope for the worst of disasters. There is nothing God cannot do and nothing God cannot fashion. After all, everything we know and treasure was once nothing, and look what God did with the nothing God had! The resurrected Christ stands before us with nail marks in his wrists and wounds on his body as a testament that not even injustice, suffering and death can trample over and destroy God's mercy. What have we to fear? Why do we keep ourselves from peace? Our lack of faith prevents us from going forward and fully receiving the holiness God desires to breathe upon us. The Suicide Crisis – What Can I Do?



Webinar | April 13 | 7:00 pm
Suicide rates in the United States have been climbing for 20 years, following a 15-year period of decline. Rates are increasing in almost all demographic groups. This was true even before the pandemic.

Did you know that suicides are often preventable? On Tuesday, April 13, at 7:00 pm, our Director of Family Life and Adult Education, Dr. Dale Wisely, will be on YouTube Live to give straightforward ways to communicate with those who we worry may be suicidal. Dr. Wisely is a clinical psychologist with more than 35 years of experience as an educator on mental health topics, including depression and suicide.

There are not enough mental health professionals, nor is there adequate access to mental health care, to address this national crisis. However, all of us may be able to help prevent suicide by being willing to ask our friends, neighbors, co-workers, and family members questions when we are concerned that they may be struggling with thoughts of hurting themselves.

Act of Spiritual Communion

Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name.
