

“ASK FR. FARNAN”

Q: I recently saw the movie ‘Unplanned’. Wow! I recommend it to everyone. I once heard that priests were not able to forgive women and men for the sin of abortion. Is that true, or is this another example of fake news?

A: I saw the movie too. Now we know why any legislation that requires a mother view a sonogram of her baby before going through with an abortion is vigorously opposed.

There are some sins for which the canonical penalties can be lifted only by the authority of the Holy See. The sins, as well as any sin confessed in the Sacrament, of course, are never made public. Canons 1364-1399 of the 1983 Code of Canon Law discuss the offenses that merit *latae sententiae* excommunication, or immediate excommunication. And the lifting of the excommunication reserved only to the Apostolic See.

Those whose offenses merit such a penalty include “one who throws away the consecrated species or, for a sacrilegious purpose, takes them away or keeps them”; “a person who uses physical force against the Roman Pontiff”; “both the bishop who, without a pontifical mandate, consecrates a person a bishop, and the one who receives the consecration from him”; “a confessor who directly violates the sacramental seal”; and a confessor who absolves “an accomplice in a sin against the sixth commandment of the Decalogue.”

In addition to these sins, canon law provides that “a person who procures a completed abortion incurs a *latae sententiae* excommunication,” as does “an apostate from the faith, a heretic or a schismatic.” However, the lifting of these penalties, according to Canon 1356, is reserved to the Ordinary Bishop of the diocese in which they occurred.

Years ago many bishops in the United States and elsewhere, because of the multitude of people who have had an abortion and who came to the Church for Divine Mercy, lifted the need for their involvement in reconciliation of the sin of abortion. They delegated their priests the authority to lift the excommunication and forgive these sins in an effort to encourage people to make use of God’s ever ready gift of mercy.

Back at the end of August, 2015, the Holy Father, Pope Francis, formally made this rule a part of the universal norms of the Church during the Jubilee year of Mercy, beginning December 8, 2015, and going until November 26, 2016. So, not just in the United States and Britain during the year of mercy every priest is given the delegation to lift the abortion related *latae sententiae* excommunication prior to administering absolution.

Let’s hope the presence of God’s most generous mercy will encourage anyone affected by the scourge of abortion to make use of God’s instrument of mercy, His Church and her Sacraments. Let’s pray that more and more people estranged from the Church will reconcile and come back to experience the great treasure of Grace available to them.





