The procession ritualizes the journey that each of us makes to be part of that liturgy's assembly. Whether we arrived early or rushed in as the entrance song was announced, the procession demonstrates the purpose in our efforts. It calls us, now that we have physically arrived, to bring our whole selves to the altar, to be united in worship, to join in full, conscious, and active participation in the liturgy. This slow, deliberate procession quite literally leads us into the mass.

REFLECTION

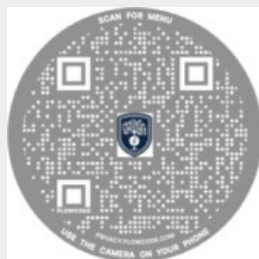
STEWARDSHIP ADVICE FROM OUR BLESSED MOTHER AND SAINT PAUL:

This Sunday's readings have a lot to say about stewardship. Saint Paul teaches: "To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit." He goes on to explain that each of us is given part of what is needed by the whole community. It is only when each of us does our part that the community thrives. At the wedding feast at Cana, Jesus invites the stewards to participate in his work. He doesn't have to do that. He could fill the empty jars with wine, even if they were not first filled with water. Every day, God invites us to participate in his plan for the world, each of us using the gifts that we have been given. Sometimes, we tend to think that we aren't gifted at all, but Saint Paul would disagree. Like the stewards who filled the jars with water, there is always something we can do for our Lord. Before we can steward our gifts for his glory, however, we must pray and listen to his will. Then, as Mary succinctly put it: "Do whatever he tells you."
