RCIA: AM I NOT HERE, I, WHO AM YOUR MOTHER?

“Am I not here, I, who am your Mother? Are you not under my shadow and protection? Am I not the source of your joy? Are you not in the hollow of my mantle, in the crossing of my arms? Do you need anything more? Let nothing else worry you, disturb you.” Our Lady spoke these words to St. Juan Diego on Mount Tepeyac in 1531. Mary speaks this same message to each of us today, as we celebrate Mother’s day during May, the month dedicated to Our Lady since the middle ages.

Everyone needs a mother, and no matter how wonderful our mothers on earth may be, everyone needs a mother whose love is perfect, unconditional and unending. That is why Jesus gave us Mary, his own mother, at the foot of the cross with his dying breath. He said to his beloved disciple what he says to each of us, “Behold your mother.” (John 19: 27) Let us pray for our mothers today and take Our Lady’s hand through prayer. POSTAL CARRIERS FOOD DRIVE RETURNING MAY 14

After a two-year pause due to COVID-19, the Postal Carriers Food Drive is returning to Northern Kentucky on Saturday, May 14th. On that day, residents are asked to leave nonperishable food at their mailboxes. Carriers will pick it up and turn it over to one of seven food-assistance organizations benefiting from the project: Action Ministries, Be Concerned, Brighton Center, Fairhaven, Pantry of Hope, St. Paul Pantry and St. Vincent de Paul. The drive resumes as food insecurity is on the rise in Northern Kentucky, according to Feeding America, with more than 42,000 people in Kenton, Campbell and Boone counties impacted. More than 11,000 of them were children.
