THE INTRIGUING PERSON OF JESUS CHRIST

In the Gospel today, a young man says to Jesus, "I will follow you wherever you go" (Luke 9:57). How intriguing that Jesus must have been for someone to say those words! Elsewhere it says, "The whole world has gone after him" (John 12:19). What was it about Jesus that made him so irresistible? We know that the gaze of Christ was a penetrating gaze of love, visible enough for the Gospel writers to record: "Jesus, looking at him, loved him" (Mark 10:21).

On the other hand, Jesus' answer in today's Gospel highlights the challenge of following him, "Foxes have dens and birds of the sky have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to rest his head" (Luke 9:58). In other words, it may not be comfortable or easy to walk in Jesus' footsteps. He tells the rich young man, "Go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me" (Mark 10:21). Following Jesus is not easy, but it brings a joy that is worth leaving everything.

Have you felt Jesus' gaze of love rest on you? Have you experienced the flames of desire to follow him anywhere? Christ is as alive and active today as he was 2000 years ago. Saint of the Week

ST. PETER AND ST. PAUL

(d. 64?)

St. Peter and Paul are both patron saints of Rome and considered cornerstones of the Church. St. Peter was one of the 12 apostles, as well as the first pope and founder of the Roman Church. He was martyred sometime around AD 64 in the circus of Nero. Since he was not a Roman citizen his death was crucifixion.



According to tradition, he requested to be crucified upside down because he did not consider himself worthy to die in the same way as Jesus. He was buried in the Vatican Necropolis which was next to the Circus.

When the emperor Constantine converted to Christianity, he decided to build a church in the saint's honor above his grave. We all know this church today as St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican City.

St. Paul was also an apostle, responsible for much of the New Testament. Although he never met Jesus, he is widely acclaimed as one of the most important apostles who spread the word of Jesus and the nascent Christianity. 13 out of the 27 books of the bible are attributed to St. Paul.

During Nero's persecution of the Christians, Paul was martyred as well. Since he was a Roman citizen his death was the more lenient beheading.
