Dear Parishioners,

In your kindness I ask you to join me in prayer for the repose of the soul of my dear friend, Rudy Eismann. Rudy has been my friend for over 47 years. The reason I am asking you, Blessed Sacrament Parishioners, to pray for



him is that he is the person who, at my request, designed and constructed the processional cross that you use for every Sunday and other major liturgies. He also designed and built the brackets on which the cross hangs in the sanctuary and in the vestibule. Rudy was diagnosed with an aggressive leukemia only a few months ago. Rudy was a native of Germany and had to flee, with his siblings, from the advancing Russian forces at the end of WWII. At the time Rudy was a young teen. He emigrated by himself to the US as a teenager and began to establish himself as a master woodworker and construction supervisor. He oversaw the construction of many of the original buildings at NKU. He also was the construction supervisor for the original buildings of St. Elizabeth Hospital in Edgewood. Throughout his life, Rudy was a staunch supporter of the Catholic faith and his local parish. Rudy died on June 16th. Please remember him in your prayers. I and his wife, Margaret, and their children will be most grateful.

### LOOKING FOR PEACE AFTER A DIVORCE?

In today's Gospel, Jesus asks his followers to proclaim, "Peace to this household." His gift of peace is intended for each of our families.



We have all likely suffered the aftermath of a divorce, either personally or in the lives of someone we love. Bob Grant, a convert to Catholicism and an RCIA Team member, shares his testimony after his marriage to Ana, who had previously been divorced. Bob attests, "It was very painful for my wife Ana to feel estranged from the church, and to know she couldn't receive Communion. One day as we drove past Blessed Sacrament, I read the church sign, 'Do you want to learn more about the Catholic faith? Come to RCIA.' With Blessed Sacrament's help, we were able to get an annulment from Ana's previous marriage. My wife was able to receive Communion again, and I could see peace return to her, despite the fact we were in the hospital at the time. She passed away several weeks later. I know that being able to receive communion was incredibly important to Ana, and I am forever grateful to Marilyn (the former RCIA coordinator) for her help."

### REFLECTION

#### JESUS' EXAMPLE OF STEWARDSHIP

### SAINT OF THE WEEK

**SAINT ANTHONY ZACCARIA'S** (b.1502 - d. July 5, 1539

At the same time that Martin Luther was attacking abuses in the Church, a reformation within the Church was already being attempted. Among the early movers of the Counter-



Reformation was Anthony Zaccaria. His mother became a widow at 18, and devoted herself to the spiritual education of her son. He received a medical doctorate at 22, and while working among the poor of his native Cremona in Italy, was attracted to the religious apostolate. He renounced his rights to any future inheritance, worked as a catechist, and was ordained a priest at the age of 26. Called to Milan he laid the foundations of three religious congregations, one for men, one for women, and an association of married couples. Their aim was the reform of the decadent society of their day, beginning with the clergy, religious, and lay people.

Greatly inspired by Saint Paul—his congregation is named the Barnabites, Anthony preached with great vigor in church and street, conducted popular missions, and was not ashamed of doing public penance.

Anthony encouraged innovations as the collaboration of the laity in the apostolate, frequent Communion, the Forty Hours devotion, and the ringing of church bells at 3:00 p.m. on Fridays. *Franciscan Media*

- Peripheral Arterial Disease screenings look for abnormalities in blood flow in the lower extremities.
- Carotid Artery screenings check the arteries uneven right alignment in the neck where plaque buildup can lead to blockages, which are the No. 1 cause of stroke.
- Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm screenings search for an enlargement or uneven right alignment aneurysm in the abdominal aorta that could lead to a reptured aortic artery.
- Cardiac Age Health Risk Assessment, based on the Framingham Heart Study, calculates a 10-year heart risk percentage based on biological age, body mass index, blood pressure, cholesterol, glucose and smoking. It requires a 4-hour fast and involves a finger stick glucose and lipid panel.
