

#### REFLECTION

#### STEWARDSHIP OF NEIGHBORLINESS

"Who is my neighbor?" In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of "The Good Samaritan" to answer this question. In this beautiful story, Jesus teaches us that we are all neighbors, regardless of nationality, race, creed, politics, or even how likable someone may or may not be. God does not ask us to judge one another but to love one another—as we love ourselves. We all know people whom we find it hard to love. Their attitude, their actions, their words annoy and sometimes even hurt us. The Good News is that Jesus gave his life for all of us—yes, them too. We are good stewards of the love we have been given when we look at everyone, not through our own eyes, but through God's eyes.

The word "polarized" is frequently used to describe our nation these days. In the time of Jesus, the same word could have been used to describe the attitudes of the Jews and Samaritans towards one another. In the parable, mercy transcends human constructs and differences. Love triumphs. Love is not a feeling, but a choice — a purposeful choice to treat one another as we ourselves wish to be treated. Let us keep this in mind: God does not require that we always agree with one another, but he does require that we show respect and love for one another. We are, after all, neighbors.

### PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR) REGISTRATION IS UNDERWAY

The Blessed Sacrament Parish School of Religion assists families with children in public schools in the faith formation of their children through a process of integrated, comprehensive, holistic, and intergenerational prayer, catechesis, and evangelization. #### SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION 1ST OR 7th GRADERS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS?

Preparation for first reconciliation, first holy communion, and confirmation takes two years. Diocesan guidelines require that children have one full year of religious instruction *prior to* the year in which they expect to celebrate sacraments. If you have children in public school grade 1, please don't wait until next year to begin their religious education. If you have children in seventh grade, and they are not currently receiving religious instruction, please contact the Formation Office now.

#### Youth Service Hours

If you are a Catholic School student, ages 12-17, you can earn service hours by assisting in the younger grades of our Parish School of Religion on the second and fourth Mondays of each month, September through May, 6-8 p.m. For more information, contact the Formation Office.

High School youth can earn service hours by assisting in the planning and leadership of our Confirmation retreat. The retreat is scheduled for March 12, 2023, 10:30 a.m.—4 p.m., and there will be one or two planning meetings prior to that. For more information, contact the Formation Office.



#### Saint of the Week

**ST. HENRY** (b. May 6, 972—d. July 13, 1024)

As German king and Holy Roman Emperor, Henry was a practical man of affairs. He was energetic in consolidating his rule. He crushed rebellions and feuds. On all



sides he had to deal with drawn-out disputes so as to protect his frontiers. This involved him in a number of battles, especially in the south in Italy; he also helped Pope Benedict VIII quell disturbances in Rome. Always his ultimate purpose was to establish a stable peace in Europe.

According to eleventh-century custom, Henry took advantage of his position and appointed as bishops men loyal to him. In his case, however, he avoided the pitfalls of this practice and actually fostered the reform of ecclesiastical and monastic life. He was canonized in 1146. *Franciscan Media*
