#### REFLECTION STEWARDSHIP ROOTED IN TRUST

Most of us learned the Christmas story as children, and we find it charming with its angels, shepherds, animals, and, of course, the sweet Baby Jesus. As adults, however, we must not



forget that there is also a young woman pregnant out of wedlock, a troubled man betrothed to this woman, a small town full of people who whisper about such things, a long treacherous journey, a woman in labor while far from home and without shelter, and a king who wanted to kill her child. LORD, we give you thanks for the gift of your Son and we remember those who have not heard the Good News. May they hear the living Gospel through us.




