**THE RITE OF ELECTION**

The Rite of Election for our RCIA catechumens and candidates will take place next Sunday afternoon at our Cathedral. It closes the Period of the Catechumenate or the information phase of the RCIA process. At this rite, upon the testimony of sponsors and catechists and the catechumens' affirmation of their intention to join the Church, the Church makes its "election" of these catechumens and candidates to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil. In the presence of Bishop Iffert, they present our parish's Book of the Elect (in which they have inscribed their names at our 11 am Mass) as a pledge of fidelity. Now the catechumens are called "the elect" and the candidates continue to be called "candidates". They now begin a Period of Purification and Enlightenment — the final, intense preparation for the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation. Over the next five weeks of Lent, three scrutinies (rites for self-searching and repentance) for the Elect, a Penitential rite for the Candidates, Anointings and Blessings and the presentations of the Creed and Lord's Prayer take place. This period concludes with the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil. Please keep Martina Schaffer, Jordan Addington, Ralph Risch, & Tonya Stephens in your prayers

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saints Jacinta and Francisco Marto
Between May 13 and October 13, 1917, three Portuguese shepherd children from Aljustrel, received apparitions of Our Lady at Cova da Iria, near Fátima, a city 110 miles north of Lisbon.



At the first appearance, Mary asked the children to return to that spot on the thirteenth of each month for the next six months. She also asked them to learn to read and write and to pray the rosary “to obtain peace for the world and the end of the war.” They were to pray for sinners and for the conversion of Russia, which had recently overthrown Czar Nicholas II and was soon to fall under communism. Up to 90,000 people gathered for Mary’s final apparition on October 13, 1917.

Pope Francis canonized the younger children on his visit to Fátima to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the first apparition—May 13, 2017. The shrine of Our Lady of Fátima is visited by up to 20 million people a year.
