


We are so glad to have you with us today here at Immaculate Heart of Mary! This is a very special day, it is the Lord's Day.



In the gospel passage today, Jesus reminds us that we are imitating Him when we serve. especially when it feels like we are giving our lives. Jesus gave himself freely. It was only because of His great love – for His Father and for us – that He was able to keep serving, keep giving. We must be sure that our motives are pure and always based in love. that's what we do for God's glory only, and never for ours. The apostles James and John ask Jesus for a favor. How does this make you feel? Do you think they really understood what they were asking? Do we understand that Jesus' expectations of the apostles apply to us?


