


Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

The same is true for us. Often we feel that we are unworthy to be in the group of disciples of the Lord. Jesus trusts us. He trusts us to do the work he has assigned us to do.

The correct tools are needed for catching fish. To fish you need a line, hooks, worms, needlenose pliers, a first aid kit, sunscreen, and a boat. What do you need to catch people, to bring people to God? You need love, patience, and kindness – to start.

How are we catching fish? Do we do the work the Lord has called us to do? May the Holy Spirt strengthen us to do the Lord's work and build his kingdom
