

PASTOR NOTES

Today and tomorrow, Assumption Parish will hold its annual Forty Hours Eucharistic Devotions. The devotions will begin with the 11:30a.m. Mass which will include the Anointing of the Sick after which there will be exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the body of the church until 5:30 p.m. when we will have Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament after which the Eucharist will be moved to the Divine Mercy Chapel. The chapel will close at 9:00p.m. as usual.

On Monday, September 11, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in the body of the church after the 8:30a.m. Mass until the closing ceremonies at 7:00p.m. The ceremonies include a Liturgy of the Word, Eucharistic Procession, and Benediction.

The Forty Hours devotion is a time of great grace in our parish. While it is true that we have the great blessing of Eucharistic Adoration on a daily basis, these few days are a special time to pay homage to Our Eucharistic King. I would like every organization to spend some time during these two days in adoration. I am grateful for all those who have committed themselves for a period of adoration. I also urge everyone to come spend time with Jesus, even if you already have an hour of adoration that you serve each week. The blessings you receive will be inestimable.

I would especially like to take this opportunity to thank all those who by their dedication and loyalty maintain their time of adoration of Jesus in the Eucharist at our Divine Mercy Chapel. I would also like to issue a challenge for more people to commit to this act of devotion. I can remember when the Divine Mercy Chapel was open 24 hours a day with all time slots filled, sometimes with 2 or more people. This is a good time to commit yourselves to this practice or recommit as the case may be. Only you can count how many blessings and favors granted in your time with our Eucharistic Lord. May God reward you for your loving service.


