#### Bible Study - Lectio: Philippians: Life in Christ



Toward the end of his life, under arrest and awaiting trial in Rome, Saint Paul writes a short but powerful letter to the Philippians. The Philippians were not only Paul's sons and daughters in the Faith but also his partners in sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ. At the heart of this letter is Paul's eloquent hymn of Christ's total gift of self, the model for Paul's life. In six video sessions, Dr. Tim Gray combines insight and practical guidance using the lectio divina disciplines to make the Scriptures come alive. Deacon Dave Lucheon will offer two

sessions, one beginning on Thursday, January 6, 2022 from 9:30am to 11:00am and the second beginning on Monday, January 10, 2022 from 12 noon to 1:30pm. 
#### POPE FRANCIS WANTS TO HEAR FROM YOU!


