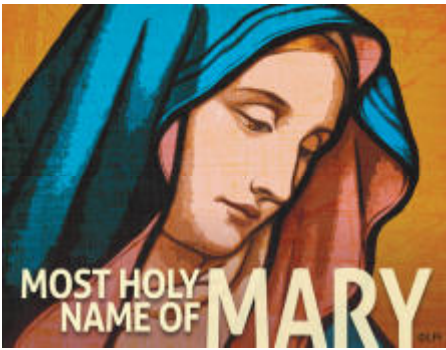

The Rosary is prayed each Sunday at 8:00 am and each Thursday at 6:00 pm



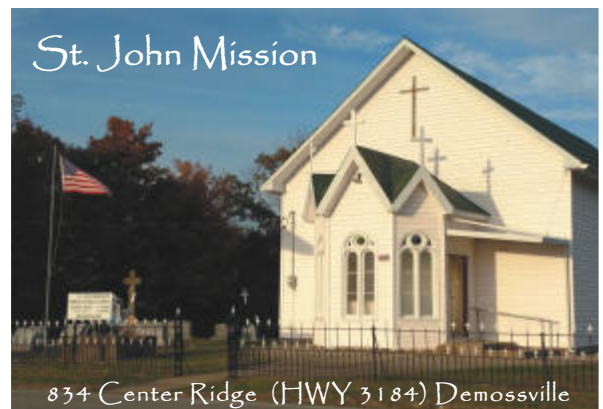

## Liturgical Ministries

*Resuming the discussions concerning liturgical ministries, I wanted to explore a ministry that often gets overlooked but is vital.*

### Hospitality Ministry

This ministry consists of the tasks of greeting worshipers as they enter the church and ushering people to their seats. They are entrusted with promoting a sense of welcoming and belonging to all the faithful assembled for worship. More and more, this ministry is also charged with safety and security of the assembly. With Church shootings and threats from viruses, these ministers are called to be a line of defense. They are the first point of contact for the communal celebration of the Liturgy and because of this, should take special steps in being living representatives of the Parish. Ministers of Hospitality minister to the entire community in a very active way. By freeing each person of their own personal impediments to the Mass through a welcoming atmosphere, ministers of hospitality take an active role in enabling each person to come to a freer expression of God in the Liturgy.

The Ministry of Hospitality is truly a service to the Church and should be treated seriously and with great dignity. Therefore, Ministers of Hospitality should have an understanding of the Liturgy in order to be effective in providing the faithful with the proper environment.

The ministers can be Jesus' face to those persons coming into the church: patience, reverence, sensitivity, compassion, understanding, gentleness, embracing a sense of the family as worshipers are gathering as the Body of Christ.

In general, ushers carry the responsibility for the following:

- Seating those assembled for Liturgy and especially taking special efforts to seat the faithful during the natural breaks in the Mass.
- Attending to the needs of the disabled.
- Checking the worship space to make certain that it free from clutter
- Circulating the baskets to facilitate the offertory collection in a timely and orderly fashion.
- Adhering to the Guidelines from the Diocese pertaining to the collection of monies during the Mass.

Many times the hospitality ministers provides visitors and new parishioners with the face of our Church. They can form the first impression to people as they come into Mass as such they can be encouraging of Mass participation and participation in the larger life of the parish.
