Liturgical Ministries

This is the final installment on the discussions on liturgical ministries.

Altar Servers

The modern form of liturgy that we exercise today has evolved in many different ways. Some changes came about when the organic culture the Church was immersed in changed. Mostly in the areas of gender relations. The role of women in the world produced changes in the role of women in the liturgy. Altar service is prime example of the change that has taken and is taking in liturgy.

Serving at the altar was reserved to males until recent developments over the last few decades. Altar serving came out of the understanding that the male only hierarchy was to be served only by those who would be on track to serve the Church as ordained, priest.

Since priests could only be male, anyone “in line” for forming into priests also needed to be male. From this understanding the “old school” Church was made up of **orders**. Some **orders** have been retained, others have been combined and still others have become extinct. They were classified into two categories, Non-Sacred or Minor Orders: **Porter, Reader, Exorcist and Acolyte**, and 3 Major Orders: **Sub-deacon, Deacon and the Holy Priesthood**.

The minor order of Acolyte was responsible for much of the duties of what we understand as Altar Server.

The main purpose of having altar servers is to aid in the worship of the people at Mass. The altar servers should be the “first prayers” the first participants, the leaders in the response to the priest-celebrants actions. Servers carry the cross, the processional candles, hold the book for the priest celebrant when he is not at the altar, carry the incense and censer, present the bread, wine, and water to the priest during the preparation of the gifts or assist him when he receives the gifts from the people, wash the hands of the priest, assist the priest celebrant and deacon as necessary.

All this assistance is designed to limited large distracting movements of the priest celebrant upon whom the congregation is basing its participation on. The role of altar server is critical in the controlled execution of the parts of the Mass in ordered ways that brings dignity to the celebration.
