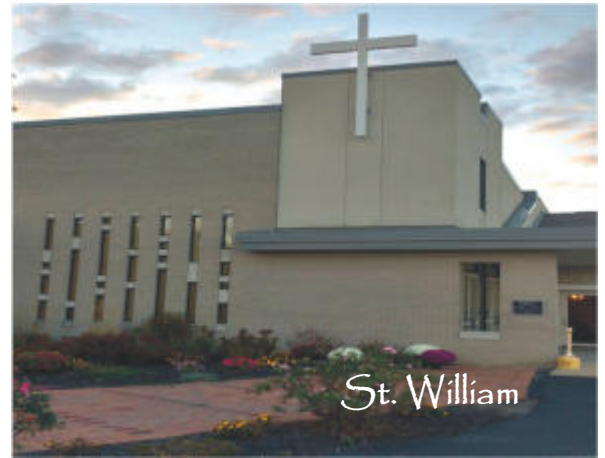

Adoration of the Holy Eucharist is offered Wednesday after the 8:30 am Mass until noon.

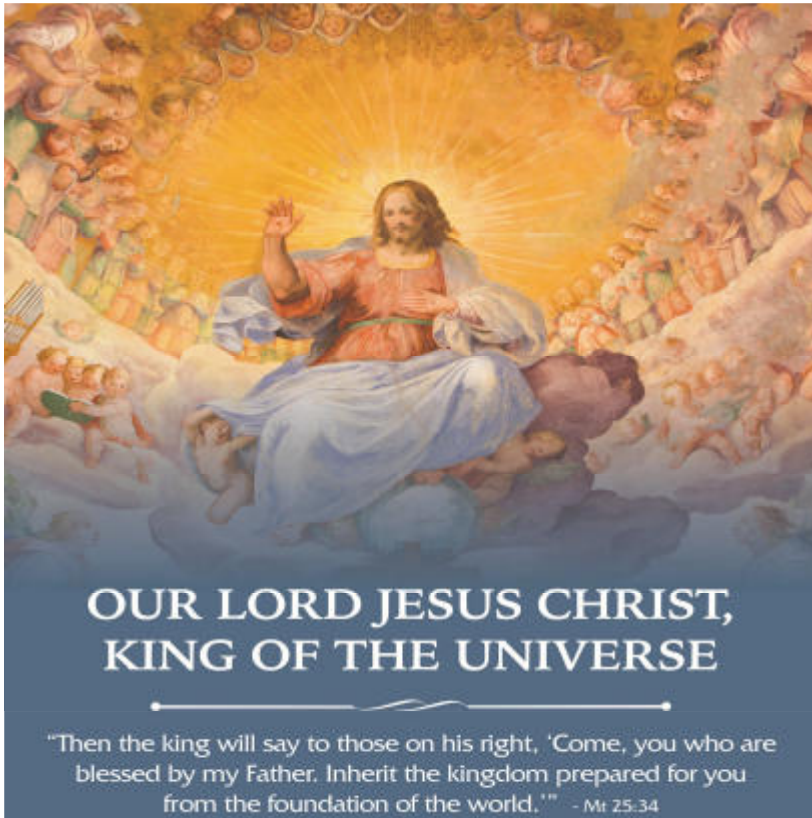
Stations of the Cross will be offered each week during Lent at 6:30 pm on Thursdays.

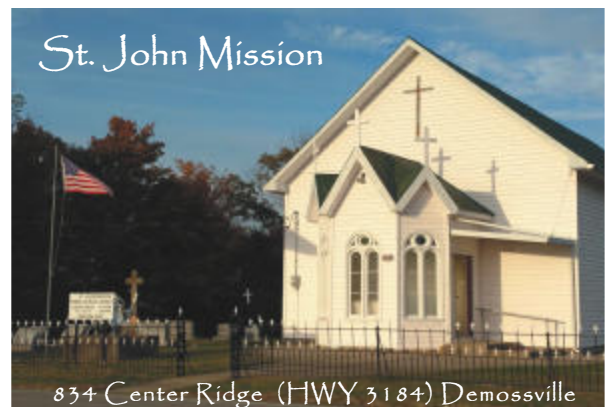

Daily Liturgical Adjustments

The Liturgical Year is coming to a close and as such, it is a good opportunity to review and make adjustments in the current daily Mass Schedule. The daily liturgical schedule is made so that the most Mass attendees can participate and by targeting a variety of times that may accommodate people's work and family schedules in order to allow for attending daily Mass periodically. Daily Mass many times can be a fulfilling experience in ways that may be a little different from the Sunday liturgies. While still maintaining reverence and pious devotions, daily Mass is a bit less formal, the celebrant can explore different types of Masses, such as Memorials to Saints, and Feasts and others that are less restricted by the rubrics or rules than the Sunday Solemnity celebration.

The daily schedule can be adjusted to align with certain events that occur on the same day every week. The goal is to maintain a regular, periodic and repeating schedule so that parishioners might be able to adjust their to be regular attendees.

The regular daily schedule is below. This is the "normal" week and when holidays occur within the week, the schedule will need to change temporarily, but advance notice will be given. Highlights of the changes are: Adoration always on Friday after daily mass, the close with Benediction will occur at 11:00. Wednesdays the 10:30 Mass at St John and 6:00 PM at St William. This will be an evening Mass offering to accommodate those who work during the day, and those who serve on the various parish committees.

The changes will take place the First Week of Advent., November 29, 2020.

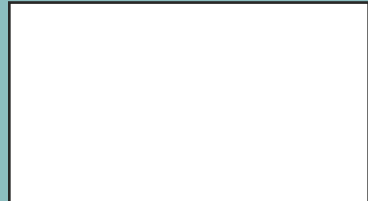
