The Rosary is prayed each Sunday at 8:00 am and each Thursday at 6:00 pm



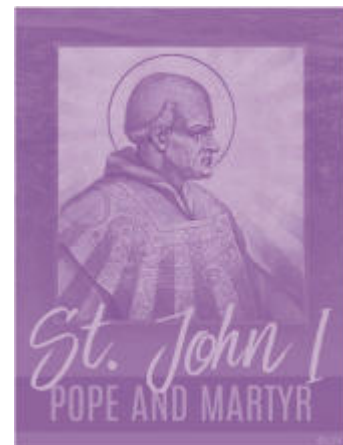
## THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD
