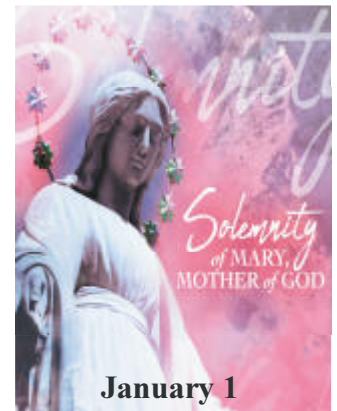

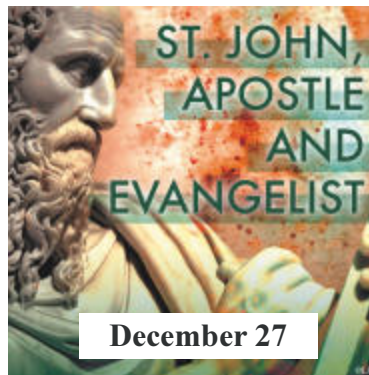
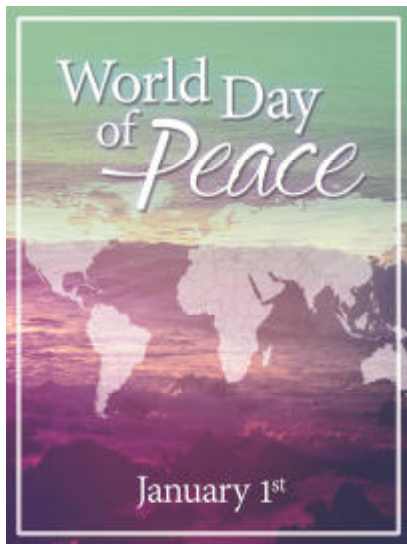
2022 Annual March For Life—Washington D. C.

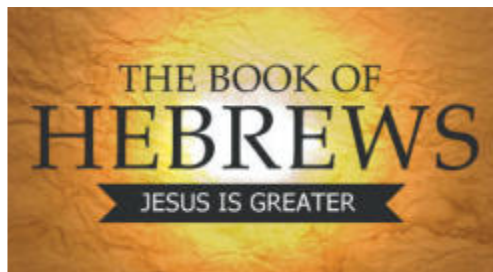
