









Dear Friends and Family of Saint Ann Parish,

How do we measure success? As pastor, it is easy to claim victory or defeat by pointing at numbers on a page or people in the pews. But, I am convinced that numbers are not the goal, but rather a consequence of the depth of faith, sacrifice, and love found at this parish. The Gospel cannot be mass-produced, but is shared from person to person. Our parish is healthy not because of our balance sheet, but because of people who are willing to "go deep" with others. I give thanks to God and the many people who make this parish what it is: a place of prayer, teamwork, and discipleship.

That being said, we know it is important to share some of the numbers and work that is done "behind the scenes" at Saint Ann Parish. You can see that this past year, the parish (Church + School) has a sizable positive net revenue. It has been a long time since the Parish has seen such substantial revenue and is not expected to happen in the future. The large net revenue can be attributed to Federal and State grants and aid related to the pandemic, increased parish size, increased school enrollment, and countless cost-cutting decisions made by every staff member. Many things were made possible by generous gifts to fund things that were not in the budget. Some highlights include: replacing equipment, upgrading systems, hiring staff, and new marketing initiatives. We added an entire classroom of students (PreK-3). We've also taken advantage of interest-bearing accounts through the diocese and started seeing fruit from our revitalized endowment over the last two years. The parish was also treated to numerous Centennial celebrations over the past year, which were made possible by generous support of local businesses and parish families. Overall, very quick growth, rare government support, and smart financial decisions gave us an unexpectedly positive balance sheet.

Due to the growth of the school and church, revenue has increased, and so have expenses. The COVID pandemic increased the cost of cleaning. Additional classes required new equipment, materials, and staffing. The Centennial celebrations, including the grotto are reflected in our expenses. So were major repairs, replacements, and upgrades to things like: roofs, HVAC systems including COVID upgrades, computers and servers, a fire alarm panel, rectory painting, and new security cameras around campus.

Recent and upcoming expenses include: a conversion of a Church breaker-box panel into a safer and more usable light switch panel, the purchase of an adjacent residential property, exterior window/door safety enhancement, and three legacy campaign projects.

As you can see, there has been tremendous work done in and around campus to (1) adapt to the COVID restrictions as well as preventing outbreaks, (2) maintain and invest in the physical infrastructure of the parish buildings, (3) celebrate a historic centennial, and (4) preparing for the future by strategic purchases and investments. Thank you for your generosity to Saint Ann Parish. We are very grateful for your continued support with your time, talent, and treasure. Be assured of my continued prayers for you and your family. God bless.
