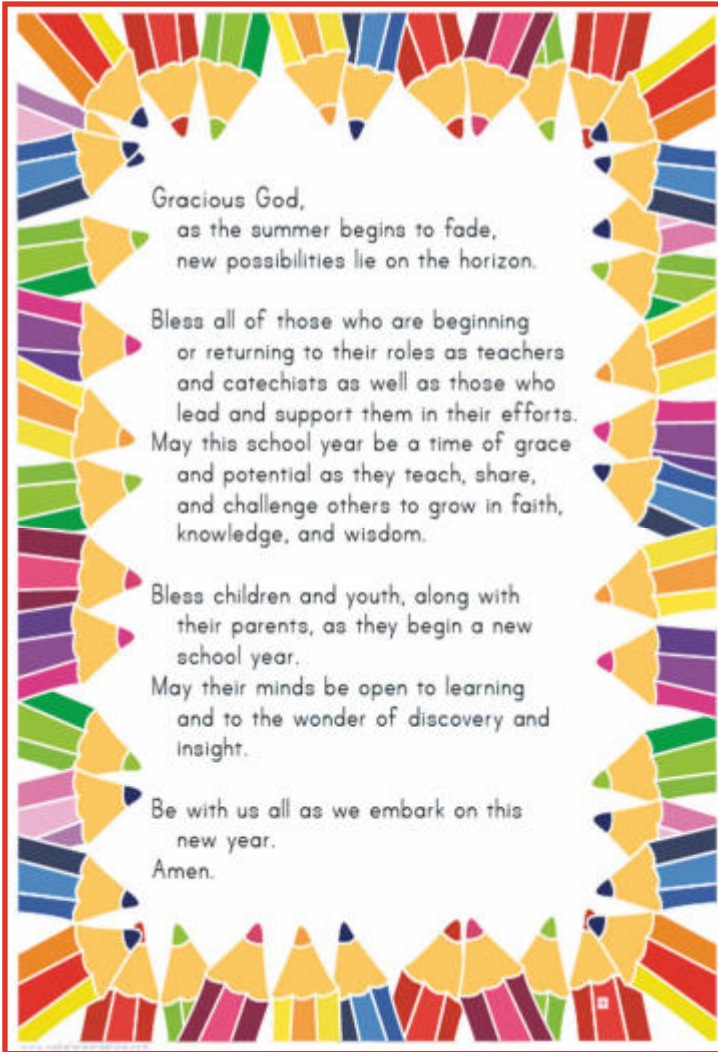

#### Baptism
