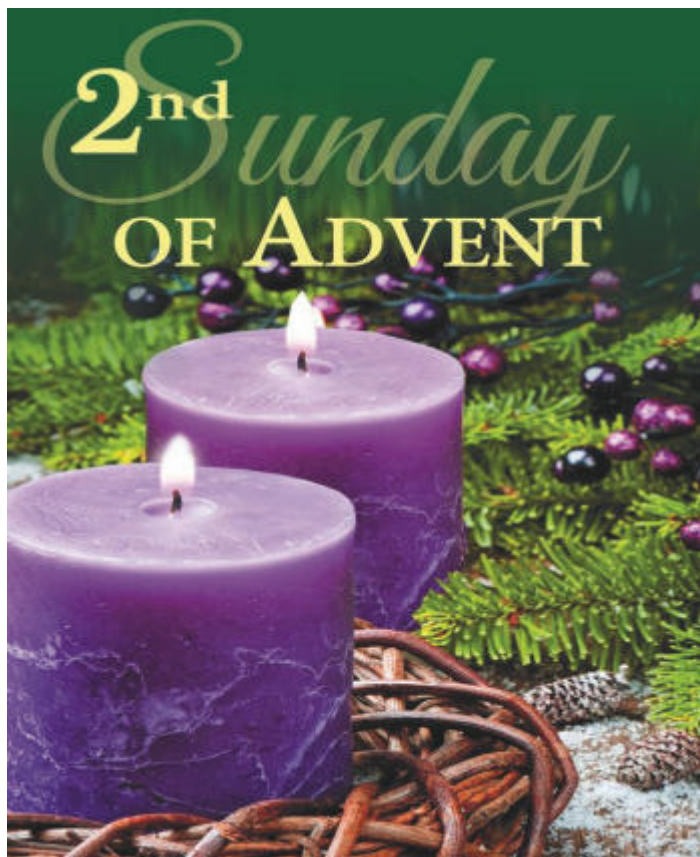

Baptism
