Hopefully, we can celebrate the May Crowning Outdoors. If the weather is rainy or chilly we will celebrate indoors. Please know that the May Crowning will be broadcasted on 96.3FM if you prefer to remain in your car. The deadline for our Savers Fundrive is right around the corner! Be sure to drop off your gently used soft items by Thursday, May 5th by 4:30PM. Thank you for supporting our Fundrive. Proceeds will go to our Capital Improvement Fund. Since we are on the topic of generosity, thank you for signing up for our Parish Festival! We still have many spots available. Also, our Parish Festival 50/50 Raffle is off to a great start. Hopefully, we can exceed \$42,000 by the time of the drawing. Our Bake Sale is next weekend, just in time for Mother's Day! MASS BOOK ~ 2023


The Mass Book for 2023 will be open on Tuesday, May 10th from 9:30-11:30 am ~ Room 103. The Mass schedule is:

Because of the number of requests we receive and the fixed number of masses available for scheduling in any year, we will continue with the following policy:

- 1. You may schedule two (2) intentions beginning on May 10th~ <u>One Weekend and</u> <u>One Weekday Mass.</u> This insures that a greater number of parishioners will have an opportunity to participate in this devotional practice.
- 2. After Labor Day, when most people have had a chance to schedule their intentions, any remaining unscheduled Masses will be made available for a second round of requests.

SACRAMENTS

SACRAMENTS Baptism

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. If you are interested please contact the Parish Office. Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who are interested in being welcomed into the Roman Catholic faith through Baptism may contact Mary Lou Beers at (440) 725-3198.

First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to complete the Sacraments of Initiation through Eucharist may contact Mary Lou Beers at (440) 725-3198.

Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. If you are interested in finding out more, you can call or email Fr. Steve Breck at (440) 854-6017.

Marriage

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information.

Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.
