



From Fr. Steve...

Happy December Everyone! I hope your Advent Season is off to a good start. Remember, we have many events throughout Advent to get you spiritually ready for the Christmas Season. Wrapping up the end of the year can be busy at school, work and around the home as you get ready for Christmas or holiday travel. So, I hope you can take the time and at least attend one of these Advent events. With that, December 8th is our country's patronal feast, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Immaculate Conception is a Holy Day of Obligation this year. The Vigil Mass is on Wednesday, December 7th at 4:30PM. Please know if you go to the 9AM on December 7th for the Memorial of Saint Ambrose and receive Holy Communion, you can come back in the evening for the Vigil Mass and receive Holy Communion again because these are two different Masses with different readings and orations (prayers). Masses on December 8th are at 9AM and at 7PM. Br. Mick Joyce OFM Cap will be the celebrant at the 7PM Mass. Welcome Br. Mick! Thank you for supporting the Holiday Craft Show on Saturday, November 26th and participating in #WeGiveCatholic! Thank you for your generosity. Because of your help with #WeGiveCatholic, we can spruce up the Church restrooms and the landing with new floors. I hope to these completed by the beginning of 2023. Please know that the Family Restroom and the Sacristy Bathroom will be open while the project is being completed. Our Diocese invites you to pray the night prayer of the Church at different parishes in the Diocese of Cleveland. "Nine Nights of Night Prayer" is underway and will wrap up on December 8th with ice-cream! The churches will be open for night prayer 8:15pm-9 pm each night. The nearby parish taking part in this opportunity for prayer Our Lady of the Lake Parish in Euclid. This past September, the Diocese of Cleveland contacted Meitler, a consulting group to partner with the elementary schools and their surrounding parishes in Lake & Geauga County. The diocese is in the process of finalizing the strategic plan (Keeping the Faith) for their Catholic elementary schools. This strategic plan should be finalized and promulgated in January 2023 during Catholic Schools week. This plan will call for collaboration, sharing resources, leveraging talent, and embracing the principle of subsidiarity. The bishop wants parishes and schools to work together to find long-term solutions to assuring irresistibly Catholic, academically excellent, operating well, and accessible to all, schools in all areas of our diocese. The role of this consulting group is to help the schools and parishes in Lake & Geauga County to reflect on the Diocesan Strategic Plan (Keeping the Faith) and to help have conversations of educating, assessing, and analyzing the needs in these two counties to bring to fruition the Diocesan plan. So, please keep the parishes and schools in Lake & Geauga County in prayer. God bless!

Baptism

First Communion

Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.


