



Happy 4th Sunday of Advent everyone! This Advent we are getting our money's worth! A full four weeks of Advent. This week is the last week for our Advent Holy Hour and Taize Prayer. Thank you for attending these opportunities for prayer and reflection. Speaking of reflection, many of you took an Advent Blue Book to help you get ready for the Christmas Season. I hope you enjoyed the daily reflections. These are great little books indeed! If you were unable to attend our Communal Cluster Evening of Confession, have some opportunities this week for you to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Confession times are Monday, December 19th from 5:30PM to 6:15PM and Tuesday, December 20th from 5:30M to 6:15PM. There's no Confessions on December 24th. Confession will resume on December 31st at 3:15PM. Looking for a last minute gift item to put under the tree or in a Christmas Stocking? Good news! Mega Raffle tickets are still available. If you like to learn about the history of this popular carol, go to the Catholic News Agency Website and type in the search bar, "History of the Twelve Days of Christmas." I learned that this English Carol was written as catechism song to teach the youth about our faith. From 1558 until 1829, Roman Catholics in England were not permitted to openly practice their faith, so the song has a hidden meaning to teach children about our beliefs. For example, the three French hens represent the three theological virtues of "faith, hope & love." Also, the "true love" in the song is Jesus. Jesus is also the partridge because that bird is willing to sacrifice its life to protect its young. So, as Catholics in England went about singing this Christmas Carol openly, non-Catholics had no idea that the six geese a laying was about the six days of creation. So, if you want to impress your family and friends while enjoying a Christmas Goose, share with them this fun little Christmas fact. Or pull up the article and see if anyone at the table can guess what each number represents. Maybe if they answer correctly, they get a piece of ribbon candy. Baptism

First Communion

Confirmation

Anointing of the Sick

Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.


