From Fr. Steve...

Next weekend January 28th is our Anniversary Dinner and our MegaRaffle Drawing! Thank you for your support of the MegaRaffle! It is hard to believe January is almost over and the short month of February is near and it is a busy one! With that, the feast of St. Blaise falls on Friday, February 3rd. The blessing of throats will be conferred during Mass at the end of the general intercessions and at all the Masses on the 4th & 5th. Individual blessings will be offered after the Final Blessing. The Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace and the International Union of Superiors General has designated February 8th as an annual day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking. Not only is February 8th the Feast of St. Jerome Emiliani, but it is the feast day of St. Josephine Bakhita, who was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery in Sudan and Italy. Once Josephine was freed, she became a Canossian nun and dedicated her life to sharing her testament of deliverance from slavery and comforting the poor and suffering. She was declared a Saint in 2000. On February 8, Catholics all over the world are encouraged to pray and grow in greater awareness about this phenomenon. Through prayer, we not only reflect on the experiences of those that have suffered through this affront to human dignity, but also comfort, strengthen, and help empower survivors. The following prayer can be used: "O St. Bakhita assist all those who are trapped in a state of slavery. Intercede with God on their behalf, so they will be released from their chains of captivity. Those whom man enslaves, let God set free. Amen." 2023 Catholic Charities Appeal kicks off in January with the theme, "A time to heal, a time to help." Soon, you will receive a letter from Bishop Malesic. The goal is \$14 million and is needed to serve more than 400,000 people in need. Donations can be made online or by texting CCHOPE to 41444. This year's In-Pew Appeal is February 18th & 19th. National Marriage Week is February 7th-14th. This year's theme, "Marriage...One Flesh, Given and Received" highlights the one-flesh union of husband and wife that is willed by God. It also indicates the personal self-gift of each spouse, one to the other. These concepts point to Christ who gives Himself under the appearance of bread and wine—as real flesh and blood. National Catholic Schools Week is January 29th to February 4th. The theme this year is "Catholic Schools: Faith. Excellence. Service." God bless all our Catholic Schools! This weekend is The El Salvador-Latin American Collection. This is the only appeal made that supports the Latin American Mission in El Salvador. Lastly, Monday, January 23rd is a day of prayer for the legal protection of the unborn of children. Please pray for the unborn and may we all continue to grow in a deeper respect for life in all stages of existence. God bless!

### SACRAMENTS **Baptism**
