

The second semester is under way in the junior high and the students have been very busy. The eighth-grade students have filled-out high anxious to get their acceptance letters around Lake Catholic, NDCL, St. Ignatius, Gilmour, and Beaumont. Some will be attending public high schools. They are all one step closer to high school!

The STREAM class had a guest speaker who talked to them about entrepreneurship. Mrs. Dana Pfahl, who is an All Saints parent and owner of *Burnt Timber Swings*, spoke to the students about her experience starting a business. The 8<sup>th</sup> graders are working to create handmade products, learning about production, marketing, brand logo and the cost of goods.

All of the students at All Saints are taking the winter MAP tests in Reading, English, Math and Science. These are standardized tests that are taken 3 times a year to track progress and growth in these key subjects.

The students were reminded that we are each just small, individual pieces of God's great plan and that we must work together in order to help His plan succeed. They each wrote

their name on a puzzle piece and decorated it. The pieces were put together and hung at the top of the main staircase where the students can be reminded daily, as they walk by, that we must all work together. It looks beautiful when the sun is shining through the



glass blocks and is a colorful reminder to us all that God has great plans for us!



### SACRAMENTS **Baptism**

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. ### **First Communion**

### Confirmation

### Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.
