## FROM FR. STEVE

Happy Easter Everyone! He is risen. He is risen, indeed! In Christ and in His resurrection, a new hope dawns for all! A hope that if we stay united to Him through faith and grace, we will rise with Him and live with Him forever in heaven. No one else offers such a hope, because no one else has risen from the dead to be able to offer it. Only the Lord! So, bask in this joy of Easter, thanking God for letting us share in this victory and for giving us this hope. If you are traveling today to celebrate Easter, may you reach your destination safely and enjoy this incredible day with your family and friends. In our Easter Sunday bulletin, there is a slick (a flyer) listing many of the upcoming events for our 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. As you can see, there are many wonderful events planned. Thank you, anniversary committee for all your hard work. Since we are approaching our 75<sup>th</sup>, I have been looking at doing some renovations to mark this occasion. Currently, I have been in conversation with Bishop Woost, Henninger's, our Parish Council and our Anniversary Committee. I also brought this to discussion with our Finance Council about the possibility of renovations to the Church. With that, I would like to install a tile floor on the top deck of the sanctuary with a stained wood nosing that would match the altar furniture and move the tabernacle so it is on the other side of the chapel's stained glass window. Thus, the tabernacle would be in the main body of the Church. We would also install a matching tile floor around the tabernacle with railings. Our tabernacle will receive a modification by creating a permanent housing window on the backside of the tabernacle to hold a Luna with a Consecrated Host. With this housing window, one can still go into the chapel to adore the Blessed Sacrament while the Church is locked after Mass. Many Churches have the tabernacle behind the altar. With our monastic style set up, the sanctuary space is limited and moving the tabernacle behind the altar would eliminate having the Eucharist in the chapel. Please know that I have not yet met with Bishop Malesic concerning this project. Also, through three generous donors, all the funds are raised to complete this entire project. As we celebrate this special time of Eucharistic Revival, I think it would be good to have our tabernacle more visible in the main body of the Church. So, when we walk immediately into the Church from the school parking lot, as well as the other entrances, our tabernacle will be very easy to locate for us to adore. Right below the choir loft Crucifix! It's nearly been 35 years since we made renovations such as this. I believe that this would be a wonderful renovation for Saint Mary Magdalene Parish and I hope many of you would feel the same way too! God bless and Happy Easter!
