For more information consult the announcement in the bulletin by the KofC. The 40 Days for Life is grateful to all who participated in the 2023 Spring Campaign. According to 40 Days for Life, as far as they know, 680 babies, mothers, fathers, and families were spared from abortion, 2 abortion workers experienced conversion, and 3 abortion facilities closed. Praise God! Cumulatively, over the 16 years of 40 Days for Life, there have been 23,525 babies spared, 247 converted abortion workers, and 138 abortion facility closures. The next campaign is September 27 through November 5, 2023. Speaking of family, the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland is delighted to announce an upcoming Catholic Family Day on June 11th, 2023 at Classic Ballpark in Eastlake. This joyous event will begin at 3:30PM with a Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession from Saint Justin Martyr Parish and end at Classic Park with an outdoor Eucharistic Liturgy celebrated by Bishop Michael Woost at 5PM. All are invited to join in this time of adoration, procession, and Eucharistic Celebration. After the evening Mass there will be picnic food, music, ballpark games and activities. ## **ALL SAINTS SCHOOL:**



The 7th grade has recently been learning about the Romans in Social Studies. While learning about the Roman Empire we've looked at their inventions and architecture. To apply this knowledge, we started a STEM project building aqueducts to transport water from one cistern to another. Students used mainly cardboard slats from recent deliveries to the school, in addition to foil, tape, paper, cardboard boxes, and wax paper. The students are attempting to create a steady flow of water on their aqueducts using math to calculate the slope needed to achieve this goal. They are excited to test out their aqueducts this coming week.




#### **LUNCH PACKING**
