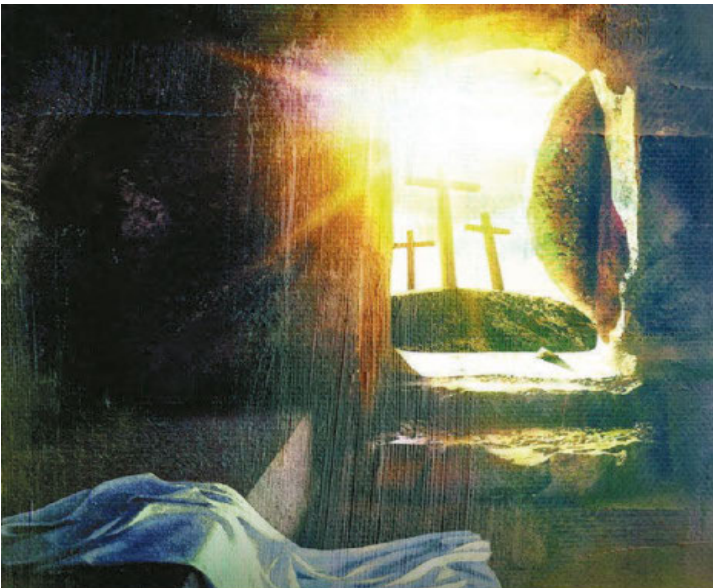

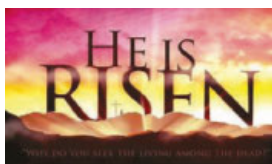

### Baptism
