

FROM FR. STEVE....

Happy Mother's Day to all our Moms! Thank you for all you do! We love you. I hope you have a wonderful Mother's Day. God bless you! I hope you are spoiled by your children on Mother's Day. You deserve it. Be assured of my prayers for those going through this Mother's Day the first time without their mom. May God comfort you, fill you with peace and help you through the day. At the entrances of the Church this weekend are empty baby bottles. Saint Mary Magdalene through our KofC is joining in the Birthright Baby Bottle Campaign. If you can afford it, please pick up a bottle. June 2nd is the Feast of Corpus Christi, The Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Once again, we will have a Eucharistic Procession at the end of the 11AM Mass. June 2nd is the last day of our festival. Right after our festival. Henningers will be coming to begin the Church renovations. Hopefully, the project will be completed by the weekend of July 20th & 21st Speaking of festivals, some of you may be familiar with the Vintage Ohio Wine Festival. This two-day event and will be held in Lake Metroparks Farmpark in Kirtland on August 2-3. Over 100 volunteers are needed for the event and most of the positions are 5-hour shifts (11am-4pm and 4pm-9pm). The VIP tent is one, four-hour shift (2pm-6pm). But most of the shifts are 5 hours. Charitable groups are given \$40 per person, per shift, where a shift is 5 hours endorsed to the organization. There is a 9am-1pm shift on Thursday, August 1 available, where volunteers will set up tables and chairs; hang signs and put cloths on the tables. We then have a total of 4 shifts spread over August 2 & 3 and volunteers can choose one, two, three or all 4 shifts. There are plenty of positions which accommodate people of all ages. Vintage Ohio will accommodate for age, disability, etc. as much as possible. Please know that a volunteer must be 21 if they choose to work at a winery or the cidery. There are positions which can be done with a buddy or individually. As long as Ms. Willard has a list of SMM people, each can work independently or as a team. Adult volunteers can choose, also, to pour wine for our wineries or in the VIP booth, which features award winning Ohio wines. Underage children are not permitted on the field and cannot come into contact with the wine. They must be accompanied by an adult for food or bathroom breaks. Interested? Also, please let her know if there are any changes in your availability to volunteer/cancellation after you have registered and signed up for SMM. Valerie will provide a complete list of St. Mary Magdalene's volunteers to Bonnie Willard at Vintage Ohio on July 25th. This is a unique and fun opportunity to raise funds for our parish. God bless!
