FROM FR. STEVE....

Monday, November 11th is Veterans Day! Veterans, thank you for your service! Thank you for your sacrifices, for your valor, for your courage, for protecting us, and your dedication to keeping us safe. God bless you! I hope you are able to take advantage of the many Veteran Freebies on November 11th at various restaurants. You certainly deserve it! Thank you for supporting our Cabbage Roll Dinner this Sunday, November 10th. Thank you, Rich Schutz and your crew for doing such a fine job! If you are looking to get out of more cooking, there is the Borromeo & Saint Mary Seminaries Novemberfest, the Annual Italian Dinner. The dinner is Saturday, November 16th from 5PM to 8PM at the Center for Pastoral Leadership. Tickets are \$12 for adults. Tickets for Children 6-12 are \$6. Children under 6 eat for free! No reservation needed! Maybe at Novemberfest, they will offer tours of the new chapel renovations. Our Thanksgiving Day Mass is on Thursday, November 28th at 9AM. At the mass we will be taking up a collection of food items during the offertory. SVDP needs pasta sauce (no glass jars, please), pasta noodles, pancake syrup, ranch salad dressing, rice, crackers and instant potatoes. Thank you for your help! On Monday, December 2nd we are having an Advent Lessons & Carols at 7PM in the Church. Saint Justin Martyr Parish will be joining us for this evening filled with music, prayers and readings from Sacred Scripture. Afterwards, we will have a social in the Kaminski Center. Also, for Advent Lessons & Carols, bring your Baby Jesus figurine from your family Nativity Scene to be blessed. Since Sunday, December 8th is the Second Sunday of Advent, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is transferred to Monday, December 9 and the Solemnity is a Holy Day of Obligation. With that, the Mass schedule is 9AM, 4:30PM and 7PM. I am told we cannot have a Vigil Mass on December 8th, so we will have three masses on the Holy Day. Fr. Garris is the celebrant for the 7PM Mass. Welcome Fr. Garris. The 50th Jubilee celebration for marriages is scheduled for June 29, 2025 at 2PM at the Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist. Doors open at 1:30PM. Everyone is invited and may bring family with them. This is not a ticketed event. There is no registration required. Starting January 2025, all couples married in 1975 may request a letter from Bishop Malesic and a certificate to commemorate the special occasion. Attendance at the 50th Wedding Anniversary Mass is not required to receive the certificate. These will be sent out on a monthly basis. Certificates must be requested online in advance. 

SACRAMENTS

SACRAMENTS Baptism

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. If you are interested please contact the Parish Office. Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who are interested in being welcomed into the Roman Catholic faith should contact the parish office ~ 440-943-2133.

First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Fr. Steve Breck at 440-943-2133.

Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. Marriage

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information.

Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.
