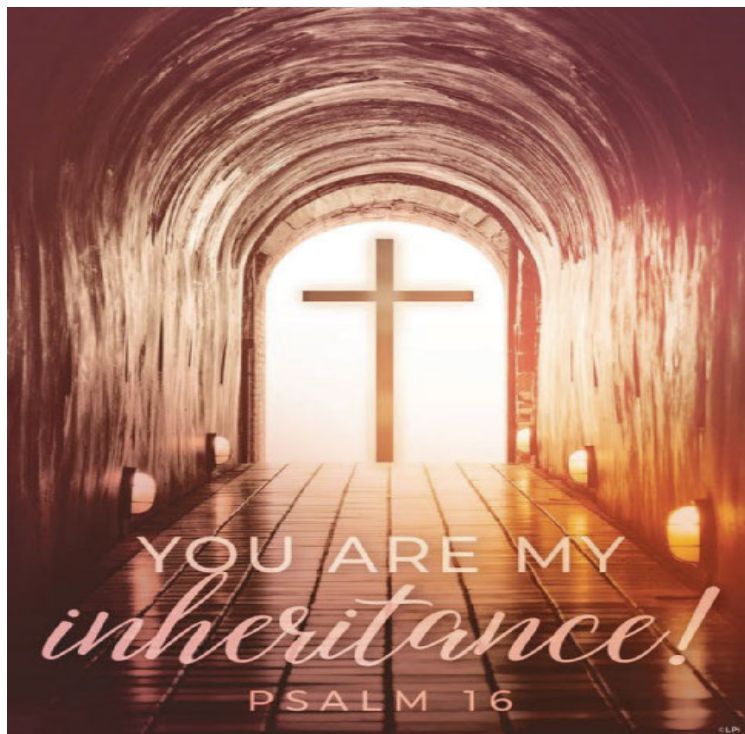

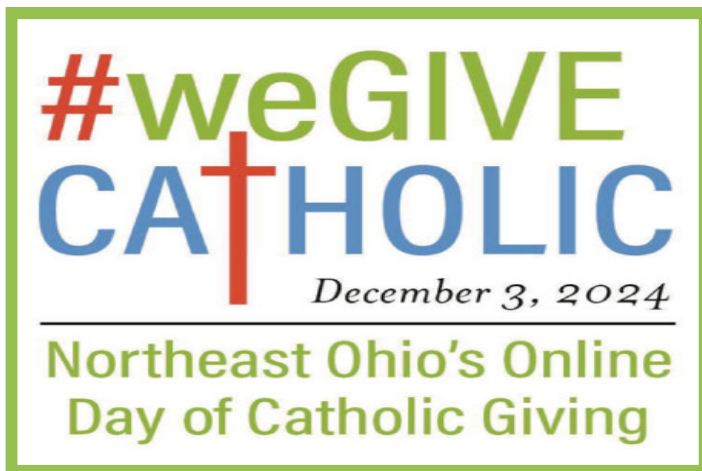

Confirmation
